## Road Resurfacing on Ambercroft Boulevard and Redheugh Crescent

As you are aware, The City of Toronto has been working to complete road resurfacing and deficient sidewalk restoration work in your area.

This work has caused some significant concerns with local residents; which the City and local councillor have worked to rectify. To ensure that similar issues do not occur in the future, City staff have:

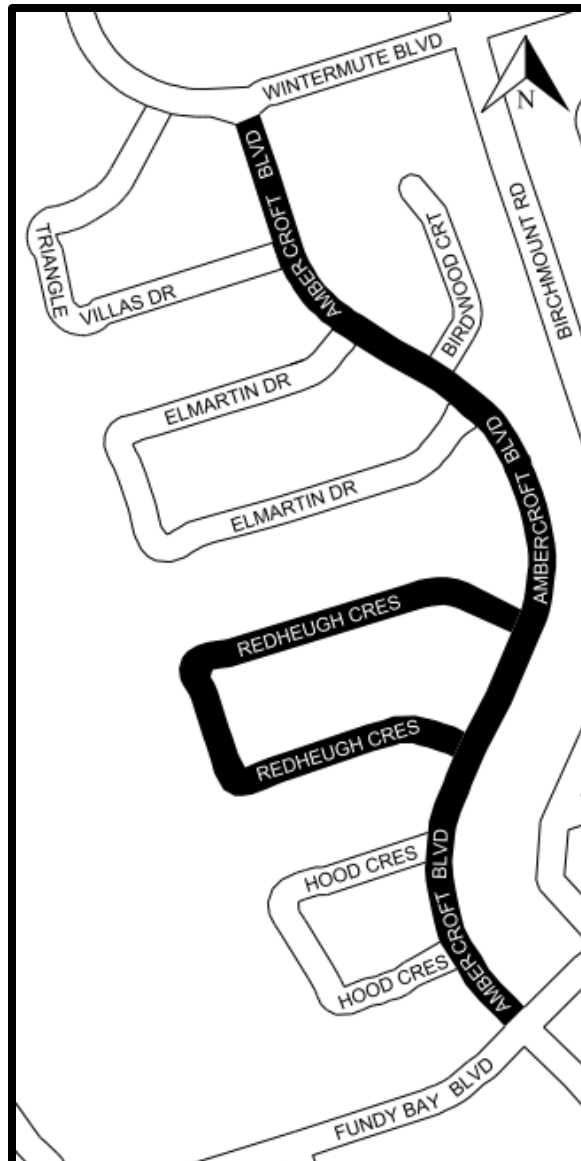
- met with the Contractor to provide detailed instructions on proper traffic controls necessary for the work;
- employed additional resources to provide proper oversight for the paving operation

We appreciate your patience during this disruption.

The final work of paving the road is scheduled to take place on Ambercroft Boulevard and Redheugh Crescent from **December 4, 2017 to December 5, 2017 weather permitting.**







This work is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and/or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please remove it.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place Monday, December 4, 2017 to Tuesday, December 5, 2017 from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets.</p> <p><b>Traffic will be reduced on streets with active construction / access may be limited when paving operations are taking place.</b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. A separate parking notice identifying alternative parking will be issued.</p>
	<p><b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.</p> <p><i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> Areas affected by construction work will be restored.</p>
