# Road Resurfacing on Ambercorft Boulevard and Redheugh Crescent

Contract: 17ECS-TI-14LR Start Date: December 4, 2017 End Date: December 5, 2017 \*Timeline is subject to change.

As you are aware, The City of Toronto has been working to complete road resurfacing and deficient sidewalk restoration work in your area.

This work has caused some significant concerns with local residents; which the City and local councillor have worked to rectify. To ensure that similar issues do not occur in the future, City staff have:


- met with the Contractor to provide detailed instructions on proper traffic controls necessary for the work;
- employed additional resources to provide proper oversight for the paving operation

We appreciate your patience during this disruption.

The final work of paving the road is scheduled to take place on Ambercroft Boulevard and Redheugh Crescent from *December 4, 2017 to December 5, 2017 weather permitting.* 

This work is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

#### **MAP OF WORK AREA**


