Watermain Replacement on Bedford Road From Machperson Avenue to Bernard Avenue

Substantial Completion Date: December 15, 2017 Site Restoration and Cleaning Date: December 22, 2017 Permanent Restoration if Required: Spring 2018


*Timeline is subject to change.

This is an update since we sent Update #6 in November. Since the last update, work has been progressing. By December 15, the contract will meet substantial completion (all the work underground will be complete) and the new watermain will be put into service.

Crews will still be onsite, restoring work areas and trenches until December 22. This work is weather dependent and may be subject to change. Due to temperature dependent asphalt work, if required, crews will return in the spring for a few days for permanent road restoration and to lay new sod.

We appreciate your patience during this work and also appreciate your patience due to significant delays on this project, which were due to numerous issues and challenges during construction. The City will be pursuing delay claims from the contractor.

NEED MORE INFORMATION?



Work Hours:

Crews of about 4 to 7 people are all that are needed for these final stages of work. Crews will be on site between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. with some later hours if required.



Traffic Management:

- Short duration lane restrictions will be required at Bernard Avenue and Bedford Road from December 14, 2017 to December 22, 2017 for trench, road and sidewalk restoration.
- All lanes on Bedford Road and Dupont Street will remain open during the remaining work.
- Restoration will be completed during off-peak hours (9:30 a.m to 3:30 p.m.) to prevent traffic disruption.



Water Service Disruptions: Water service disruption is not anticipated.



Restoration: All areas affected by the construction work will be restored and cleaned. If due to weather limitations, temporary asphalt is overlaid, permanent asphalt will be laid in Spring 2018 which will only take 2 to 3 days.
