Road Resurfacing on Eglinton Avenue West from Martin Grove Road to Jane Street



The City of Toronto started resurfacing Eglinton Avenue West. The contractor has completed the work from 100 metres east of Martin Grove Road, to Islington Avenue – phase 1 and 2.

The contractor will return in the spring of 2018 to complete the remaining phases of work. This work is being done because our inspection of the road shows that it needs repaving and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair. A new sidewalk will be added on the north side of Eglinton Avenue West between Jane Street and Scarlett Road.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs. A new update will be distributed before work starts in the Spring.

WORK DETAILS

Work on this project will be delivered in five phases, starting west and working east. Work will be complete in one phase on both sides of the road before moving east.


Phase	Dates / Location	Work
1 North and South sides of Eglinton Ave.	Work started on September 18, 2017 and was competed on October 20, 2017. Martin Grove Road to Kipling Avenue	Work is complete.
2 North and south sides of Eglinton Ave.	Work started on October 23, 2017 and was completed on November 25, 2017. Kipling Avenue to Islington Avenue	
3 North and South sides of Eglinton Ave.	Spring 2018 Islington Avenue to Royal York Road	 Crews Will: Repair deficient concrete curb, sidewalk and driveways Regrade and restore roadside ditches
4 North and South sides of Eglinton Ave.	Spring 2018 Royal York Road to Scarlett Road	 Re-align catch basins Resurface roadway asphalt and reapply pavement markings Construct new sidewalk in the north boulevard area, from the Humber River Bridge to Jane Street (Phase 5 only)
5 North and South sides of Eglinton Ave.	Summer 2018 Scarlett Road to Jane Street
