Your Green Bin, Blue Bin, Garbage Bin, yard waste and oversized items must be set out no later than 7 a.m. and no earlier than 8 p.m. the night before your scheduled collection day. The lid opening must face the street and the bins must be set out squarely facing the street.

ITEMS NOT COLLECTED \mathbf{X} **DURING REGULAR CURBSIDE COLLECTION**

Tires, paints, solvents, flammable liquids, batteries, compact fluorescent bulbs, propane tanks and cylinders, pesticides, gasoline, syringes/needles, liquids, dead animals, sod, rocks, soil, gravel, demolition and construction materials. (For instructions on proper household hazardous waste disposal visit toronto.ca/hhw).

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT DROP-OFF DEPOTS (\mathbf{X})

Dead animals, sod, grass and clippings, rocks, soil and sand, gravel, bricks, concrete, cinder blocks, paving stones, asphalt, ammunition, asbestos, etc. Contact a private company to arrange for proper disposal of these items.

OVERSIZED ITEMS

Items that will not fit in your Garbage Bin, even when empty, are considered oversized.

Oversized items can be left next to your Garbage Bin on Garbage day for regular collection. No tags or appointment required.



Furniture

Box springs, dressers, chairs, mattresses, patio furniture, etc.



Sofa beds

It is not necessary to separate the metal frame from the sofa. For safety reasons, the frame must be tied to prevent it from springing open.



Metal

Appliances (doors removed). barbecues (no propane tanks)



Carpeting, underpad and linoleum

Items must be tied in rolls measuring no longer than 1.2 m (4 ft) and weighing less than 20 kg (44 lb).





If the tank is removable, it must be separated from the bowl.



Toilets

Luggage, skis, lamps, baby strollers, baby car seats, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OVERSIZED ITEMS

- Put oversized items 0.5 m (2 ft) away from your Garbage Bin.
- Wall units should be separated into 2.5 m (no greater than 8 ft) lengths.
- Remove doors from fridges, ovens and other large appliances.
- Tie/bundle sofa bed frames.
