Tree Inventory at Rosehill Reservoir

Expected Project Start Date: November 2, 2015 Expected Completion Date: November 18, 2015 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will be performing a tree inventory of the Rosehill Reservoir property in preparation for the installation of a new waterproofing membrane and building rehabilitation. This work will take place at David A Balfour Park, where the Rosehill Reservoir is located. Construction work will not be taking place at this time. Notices will be provided in advance of any construction work.

The Rosehill Reservoir tree inventory is scheduled for early November 2015. Arborists will be on site assessing and measuring trees and will prepare a report. All memorial trees on the Rosehill Reservoir property will also be included in the arborist report.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING INVENTORY

Trees located within the Rosehill Reservoir property line and David A. Balfour Park will be the focus of the inventory. There may be a need to assess a limited number of trees on private property that overhang the property line. If there is a need to access properties, property owners will be notified ahead of time. There is minimal noise associated with this work and no pedestrian or vehicle traffic should be affected. Every effort will be made to reduce any inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.
