#### The following items must be submitted with your application:

- a) A non-refundable administrative fee of **\$256.80** including HST (subject to change without notice).
- b) A sketch and current photograph which clearly show all relevant dimensions, the location of the street and City sidewalk, side property line(s), fence enclosing proposed café area, utility poles, fire hydrant, trees, etc., and paving material. If required to pave boulevard, more detailed drawings may be required if your proposal involves major landscaping.
- c) Copy of Municipal Licensing & Standards Business Licence.
- d) Third party liability insurance policy, satisfactory to the Commissioner (form attached).
- e) If applying for propane operated equipment, e.g., barbecues or heaters, a certificate from the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations is required for operators and equipment.

#### Upon approval of your application, it will be necessary to:

- a) Enter into an agreement with the City of Toronto.
- b) Install approved fence around the perimeter of the café and remove fence at the end of each café season.
- c) Pay an annual fee for the use of the boulevard in accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 313, Streets and Sidewalks. Fees are available online at <u>www.toronto.ca/mlsfees</u>.

Until all approvals have been granted, permits issued and agreements executed, operations of the café, any required construction, or related activities are not permitted within the City boulevard.
