Watermain Replacement on Old Orchard Grove from Bathurst Street to Elm Road

Contract: 17ECS-LU-03SU Start Date: October 10, 2017 End Date: June 2018 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Old Orchard Grove continues. We appreciate your patience as we work to complete this important infrastructure upgrade.

WHAT'S NEW

To-date, the contractor has:

- Completed the installation of the new watermain mainline in the roadway;
- Completed the disinfection and testing for water quality of the new watermain mainline; and
- Commenced connection of the new watermain to the existing watermain system and transferring properties' water services from the old watermain to the new watermain.

The contractor will:

- Complete the remaining watermain connections to the existing watermain system;
- Complete the transfer of properties' water services from the old watermain to the new watermain; and

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within the City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Field Ambassador.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	Water Service Disruptions: From time-to-time, the water supply to your property will be shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not received advanced notice, an <i>emergency water shut off</i> could have been necessary.	
8	Traffic Management : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.	
	Traffic on Old Orchard Grove will be reduced to one lane.	
R	Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222 .	
	Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i>	
	Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored. The contractor will complete this work when the weather is more consistent in the later spring and the materials needed (concrete, asphalt and sod) are readily available.
