INTRODUCTION

This was to be a mediation respecting the refusal of a total of 17 minor variances under two City of Toronto Bylaws, Bylaw 569-2013 and Bylaw 438-86, to convert the existing two-storey commercial building at 216-218 Bathurst Street into a hotel containing 30 suites, by constructing a south side one-storey addition, and a rear staircase addition.

BACKGROUND

The Committee of Adjustment refused the application and a date for mediation was set for March 6, 2018. The City Solicitor and the applicant's solicitor were in attendance and requested time to discuss settlement. I agreed and when the I returned the two parties indicated that they had substantially settled the matters in dispute between them and that the settlement might require some variations to the variances sought. However, no mediation was necessary between these two parties and none occurred.

I stated that any further dealings of this matter would require a full hearing with all parties and participants being given an opportunity to review the variances as settled and to be heard regarding them. A date was set for a hearing of the matter and new notice shall be provided.

The matter is, therefore, adjourned to be heard on May 25, 2018 with notice to be provided in accordance with the TLAB Rules.

CONFIDENTIALITY

The TLAB received no verbal or written submissions regarding the settlement and thus makes no order as to confidentiality.

STATUS OF MATTERS DURING THE MEDIATION

The matter is adjourned to May 25, 2018 for a hearing. Any revisions to the relief requested are to be disclosed to all interested persons and the TLAB forthwith on their ascertainment.
