

## Affordable Housing Office 2017 Year-End Report

New Affordable Homes Approved, Completed and Repaired

- The City of Toronto uses federal, provincial and City investments to create and repair affordable rental and ownership homes, in partnership with the private/non-profit sectors, to work toward meeting its housing action plan targets.
- Toronto has launched the Open Door
   Affordable Housing Program to kick-start
   affordable rental and ownership housing
   construction using surplus public land, fast track planning approvals and additional City
   financial incentives.
- The Open Door Program will boost Affordable Housing completions over the coming years.





















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## New Affordable Rental Homes Approved and Completed




<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The increase in homes completed between 2010-2012 reflects federal-provincial economic stimulus funding.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Affordable Ownership target increased to 400 units/year as per City Council decision, December 2015.


