Sidewalk Repairs on Lake Shore Boulevard West Between Palace Pier Court and the Humber Bridge

Contract: 17ECS-TI-12SP Start Date: March 26, 2018 End Date: March 31, 2018

The City will be repairing the sidewalks on the south side of Lake Shore Boulevard West, between Palace Pier Court and the Humber Bridge. Sidewalk access from Palace Pier Court to approximately 130 metres east of Palace Pier Court will not be maintained.

Work will include the closure of individual lanes on Lake Shore Boulevard West. A single lane of eastbound traffic will be maintained on Lake Shore Boulevard West at all times.

The City's Contractor is planning to begin work within the next 48 hours.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience minor dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone.

 Sidewalk access from Palace Pier Court to approximately 130 metres east of Palace Pier Court will not be maintained.

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

 A single lane of eastbound traffic will be maintained on Lake Shore Boulevard West at all times.

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Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.



Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. *Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.*



Residents that require accommodation must contact the City Inspector to arrange for access during the construction period.
