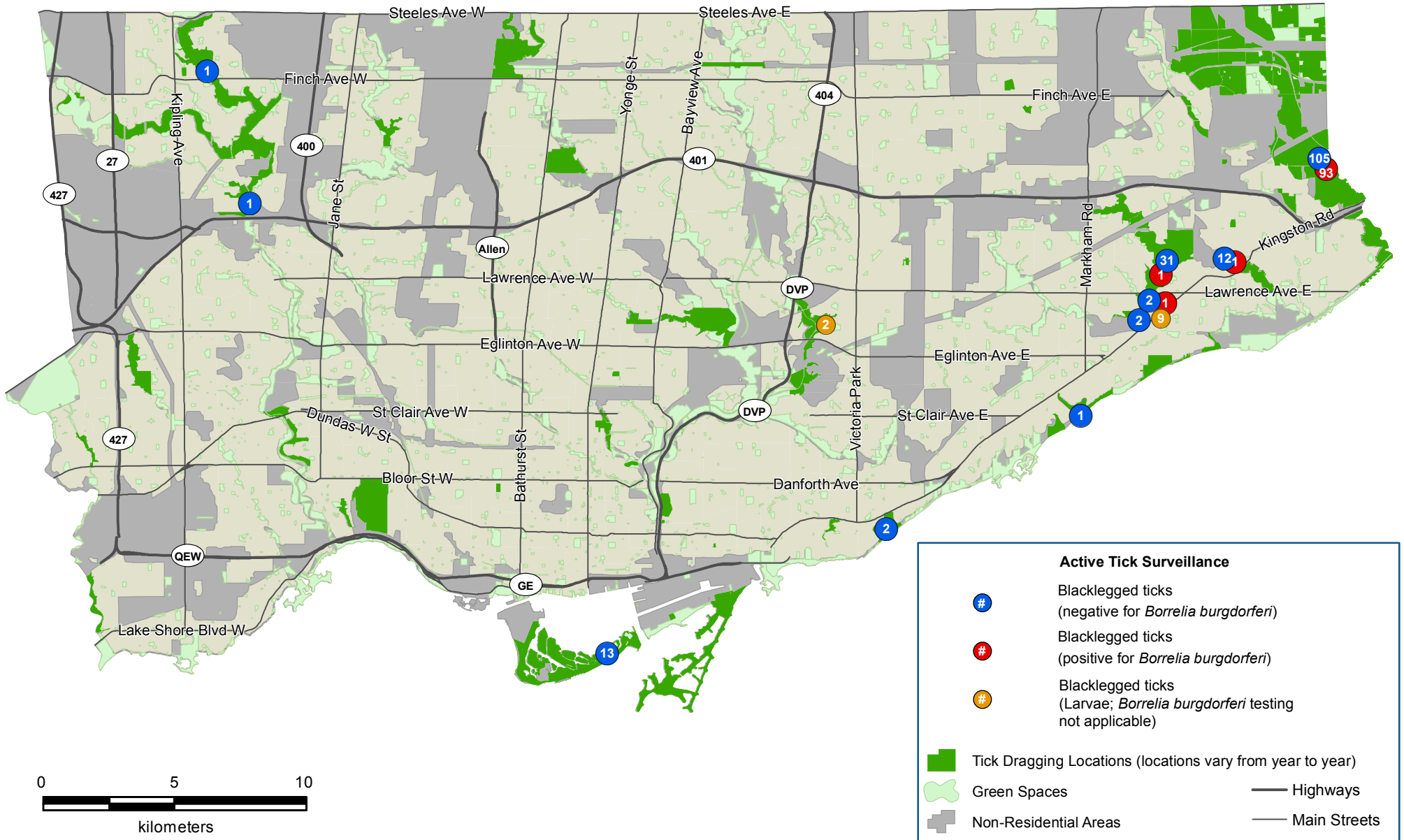


Results of active Blacklegged tick surveillance*. Toronto, 2013 to 2017 data, combined.
