Transmission Watermain Relining on Macpherson Avenue, Boulton Drive and Russell Hill Road

Contract: 16ECS-LU-01TT Start Date: March 8, 2017 End Date: September 30, 2018 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is relining the transmission watermains on Macpherson Ave, Russell Hill Road and Boulton Drive and a local watermain on Boulton Drive (see map).

The contractor will start the shaft (access pit) construction on Macpherson Avenue. Four shafts will be constructed on Macpherson Avenue as depicted in the map below. Shafts are required to access the watermain for relining.

- Due to this work, Macpherson Avenue between Poplar Plains Road and Rathnelly Avenue will be closed to eastbound traffic from March 8, 2018 to June 15, 2018.
- Detour and road closure signs will be installed.

The contractor will open the road prior to June 15, 2018 but there may be intermittent closures up to June 30, 2018 for pressure testing and disinfection.



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- The local watermain re-lining and water service upgrades on Boulton Drive is now complete.
- Relining of the transmission main on Russell Hill Road and Boulton Drive is now complete and the contractor is working at shaft locations to close the pipe and the shaft.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- There will be no impact to water service due to this work.
- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
