



Dufferin Sanitary Trunk Sewer System Improvements At the G. Ross Lord Reservoir

Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Notice of Study Completion

The City of Toronto has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to address problems and opportunities with the Dufferin Sanitary Trunk Sewer (STS) in the Dufferin Street and Finch Avenue West Area. The objective of the study is to provide recommendations for the possibility for rehabilitation and/or relocation within the study area.

Built in the early 1960's, the Dufferin STS is part of the City's Don Sanitary Trunk Sewer Collection System. Sections of the Dufferin STS in the Dufferin Street and Finch Avenue West area are located under the G. Ross Lord Reservoir, which was built in 1973 to reduce the risk of flooding to downstream communities.

Following consultation with City Divisions and the public, the following are the study's key findings, accepted by the City:

- Bring the Dufferin STS into a state of good repair;
- Re-align the Dufferin STS out of the G. Ross Lord Reservoir, along Finch Ave. W., between Dufferin St and Don River West Branch;
- Abandon the existing Dufferin STS and the West Don STS beneath the G. Ross Lord Reservoir, which will be out of service after re-alignment of the Dufferin STS;
- Rehabilitate the existing Dufferin STS south of Finch Ave. W.

Opportunities for review

The study was carried out following the requirements for Schedule B projects under the Municipal Class EA process.
