Storm Sewer Replacement on the West Humber River Trail South of Humber Gate Park

Expected Start Date: Summer 2018

Expected End Date: Fall 2018

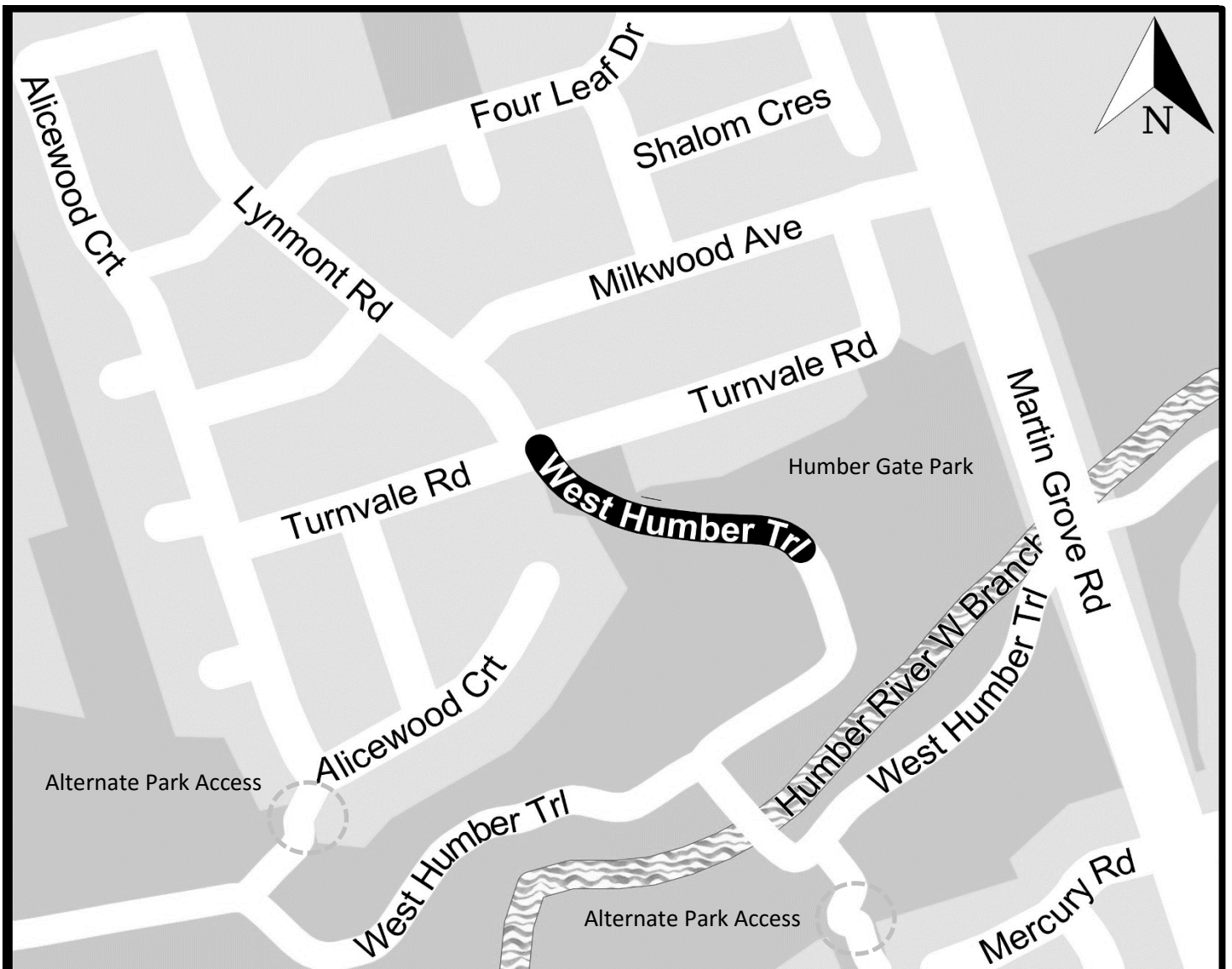

The City of Toronto is planning to replace 160 metres of the storm sewer along the West Humber River Trail from Humber Gate Park southeast.

The storm sewer is an underground pipe designed to collect stormwater and melting snow and release it into a nearby creek or river.




This project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program that will improve the City's aging infrastructure.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable to ensure they are not affected by the work.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.

	<p>Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Access to Your Home: The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.</p>
	<p>Humber Gate Park: Access to Humber Gate Park from Turnvale Road and Lynmont Road will be closed during construction. The Trail from Lynmont Road and Turnvale Road will also be closed. Please access the park from Alicewood Court and Mercury Road.</p>
