# Watermain Replacement on Castlefield Avenue At the Metrolinx Rail Crossing

Contract: 17ECS-LU-03SU Work continues: April 11, 2018 Expected End Date: June 29, 2018 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City's contractor has returned to install the final section of the planned watermain replacement on Castlefield Avenue across the Metrolinx Rail Crossing, just east of Kincort Street. This portion of work was delayed in order to schedule the work and its delivery with Metrolinx. *Please see the important information below about low water pressure expected during this work.* 

### WHAT'S NEW


Two-way access on Castlefield Avenue will be accommodated during working hours and will be fully closed at the rail corridor, resulting in a dead end on either side, after-hours as noted below.

During working hours, the roadway will be reduced to one lane, with bi-directional (2-way) traffic controlled by flag-persons and police officers on point-duty. Drivers and pedestrians are required to abide by flag-person and police traffic direction while travelling through the construction zone. This traffic control is anticipated to be in place from **April 11, 2018 to May 7, 2018** during the watermain installation. Traffic shall be restored to normal conditions thereafter with minor restoration and clean-up work to be completed by June 29.

### Lane Closure Hours:

Castlefield Avenue will be <b>reduced to one lane</b> at the rail crossing between Kincort Street and Caledonia Road. Two-way traffic will be maintained.	Castlefield Avenue will be <b>fully closed</b> at the rail crossing with no through-traffic. Two-way traffic will be limited up to the nearest driveways on either side of the tracks.

Saturdays from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM	Saturday Nights from 7:00 PM to 11:00 AM

## WORK DETAILS

#### To date, the following work has been completed:

- Watermain and water service installation on Castlefield Avenue from Kincort Street to Dufferin Street, except across the Metrolinx rail corridor east of Kincort Street
- Permanent restoration of affected sidewalks, curbs, and roadway outside the rail corridor.
- Set up and prepare necessary ground-level monitoring near the rail corridor.

#### The following work remains to be completed:

- Installation of the new watermain on Castlefield Avenue across the Metrolinx rail corridor;
- Disinfection and testing the new watermain for water quality; and
- Permanent restoration affected sidewalks, curbs, and road base at the rail corridor.

	<b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7:00am to 7:00pm, Monday to Friday, and 9:00am to 7:00pm on Saturday, with work after hours and on Sunday as required.
	<b>Low-Water Pressure:</b> Sections of the watermain will have to be isolated in order to safely complete the construction work.
	Due to this work, a reduction in water pressure during the first few weeks of the construction period is anticipated and will affect all properties on Castlefield Avenue between Kincort Street and the Metrolinx rail corridor.
	Please contact the Field Ambassador below if you have any questions or concerns regarding this impact.
	<b>Water Service Disruptions:</b> From time-to-time, the water supply to your property will be shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not receive advanced notice, an <i>emergency water shut off</i> could have been necessary.
<b>(i</b> •	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	<b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
8	<b>Traffic Management</b> : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.
