
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: May 17, 2018
Summary of Decisions

1. Masood Hejran (Report No. 6974)

Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B748288)

DECISION:

The Tribunal dismissed Masood Hejran's application for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence, and deemed the matter as abandoned (without a hearing).

(Mr. Masood Hejran failed to attend today's hearing)

2. Chaudhry Ali Ijaz Cheema (Report No. 7016)

Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B816244)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint Proposed Resolution:

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be issued to Chaudhry Ali Ijaz Cheema, Subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Chaudhry Ali Ijaz Cheema must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, his original up-to-date criminal record and an original abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Mr. Cheema's provincial driver's licence is suspended for medical reasons, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards with three (3) business days from the first day of the suspension. Mr. Cheema can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:

(5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Chaudhry Ali Ijaz Cheema, those matters and report no. 7016, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
