## Six Points Interchange Reconfiguration: Widening of Dunbloor Road

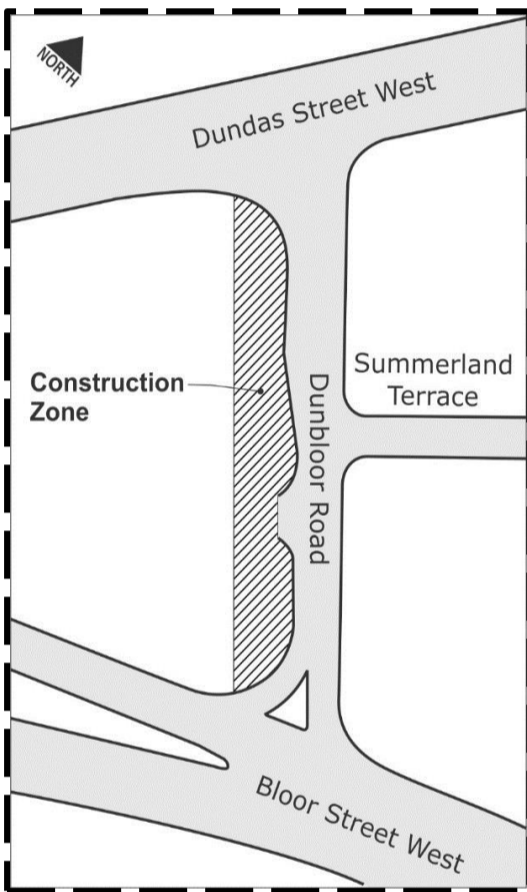

The City of Toronto continues Stage 1 construction of the Six Points Interchange Reconfiguration. Work during this stage takes place: southeast of Bloor Street and Kipling Avenue (former Westwood Theatre lands), and locations along Bloor Street West, Kipling Avenue, Dundas Street West, and some ramps.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 - 2025 Capital Budget and Plan, and supports the development of Etobicoke Centre as a vibrant mixed-use transit-oriented community. Additional Notices will be distributed as construction progresses.

### WORK AREA

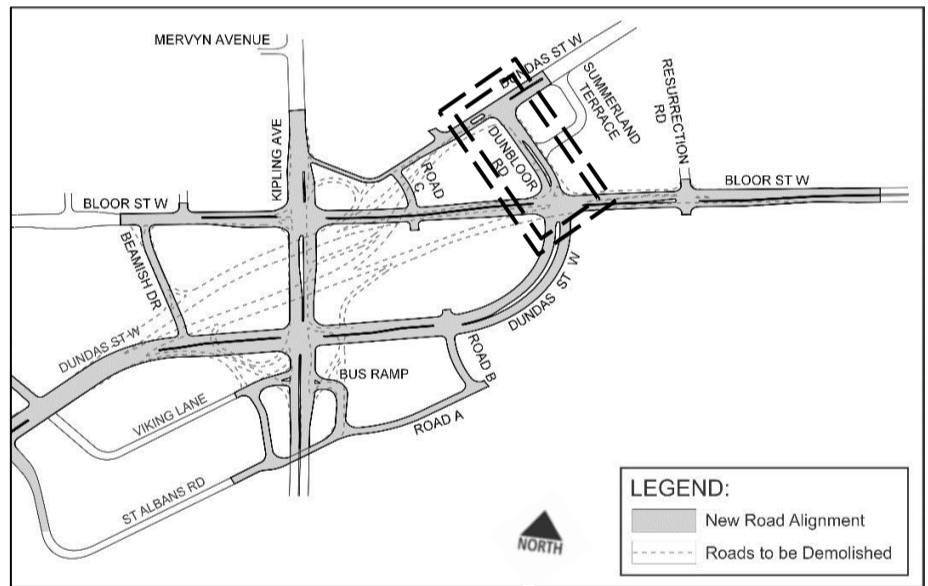


#### Description of Work

Beginning the week of March 19, 2018, construction work will begin west of Dunbloor Road to widen the roadway and construct various boulevard improvements; including clearing, tree planting, and paving.

This work is not expected to impact current pedestrian or vehicular access on Dunbloor Road.
