Watermain Replacement on Castlefield Avenue At the Metrolinx Rail Crossing

Contract: 17ECS-LU-03SU
Work continues: May 22, 2018
Expected End Date: June 29, 2018

The City of Toronto’s work to replace the watermain on Castlefield Avenue across the Metrolinx Rail Crossing, just east of Kincort Street is nearing completion and will continue with sidewalk replacement on May 22, and the final paving phase of this contract on the evening of Friday June 1, 2018.

We appreciate your patience as we work to complete this important infrastructure upgrade.

WHAT’S NEW

Two-way access on Castlefield Avenue will be maintained during regular working hours and will be fully closed at the rail corridor, resulting in a dead end on either side, after-hours as noted below.

During regular working hours, the roadway will be reduced to one lane, with bi-directional (2-way) traffic controlled by flag-persons and police officers on point-duty. Drivers and pedestrians are required to abide by flag-person and police traffic direction while travelling through the construction zone. This traffic control is anticipated to be in place from **May 22, 2018 to May 23, 2018** while the sidewalks are being restored.

The road will then be fully closed the night of Friday June 1 for paving. Traffic shall be restored to normal conditions thereafter with minor restoration and clean-up work to be completed by June 29.

Lane Closure Hours:

<p>Castlefield may be reduced to one lane at the rail crossing between Kincort Street and Caledonia Road during working activities. Two-way traffic will be maintained.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tuesday May 22 and Wednesday May 23, from 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM 	<p>Castlefield will be fully closed at the rail crossing with no through-traffic. WORK DETAILS

To date, the following work has been completed:

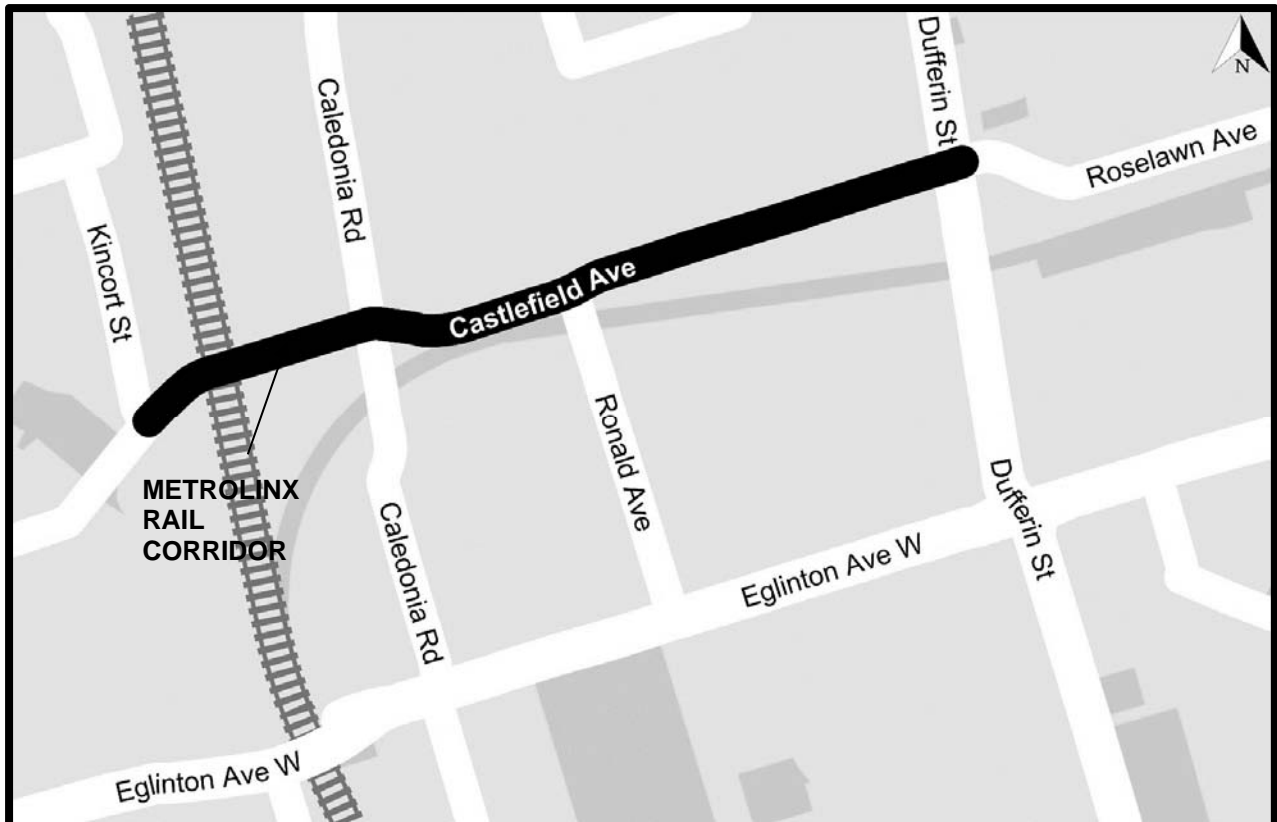
- Watermain and water service installation on Castlefield Avenue from Kincort Street to Dufferin Street;
- Permanent restoration of affected sidewalks, curbs, and roadway up to just outside of the Metrolinx rail corridor;
- Installation of the new watermain on Castlefield across the Metrolinx rail corridor;
- Disinfection and testing the new watermain for water quality; and
- Connection of the new watermain across the Metrolinx rail corridor to the existing system.

The following work remains to be completed:

- Permanent restoration of the roadway in the impacted areas just outside of the Metrolinx rail corridor.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place on May 22 and May 23 from 6:00 AM to 7:00PM, and from Friday, June 1, 2018 from 7:00PM to Saturday, June 2, 2018 6:00AM.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p>Please see above for details regarding the Castlefield traffic plan.</p>
