

Summary of Meeting

On Monday April 23rd, 2018, the City of Toronto hosted the fifth Working Group Meeting for the High Park Apartment Neighbourhood Area Character Study.

Staff presented information on the Natural Heritage Impact Study underway which will be an addendum to the Bloor West Village Avenue Study Natural Heritage Impact Study completed in March 2018. The development of a Biodiverse Landscape Manual for the High Park Area was also introduced as part of the study outcomes.

Staff updated the Working Group on the status of the Statement of Area Character which will be circulated to the group for comment as soon as it is finalized. Changes to the proposed infill development criteria metrics based on feedback received from the Working Group were explained. Staff introduced additional policy directions that may be included in the Site and Area Specific Policy for the working group to consider.

Working Group members requested that staff come to the next meeting with a presentation on population density.
