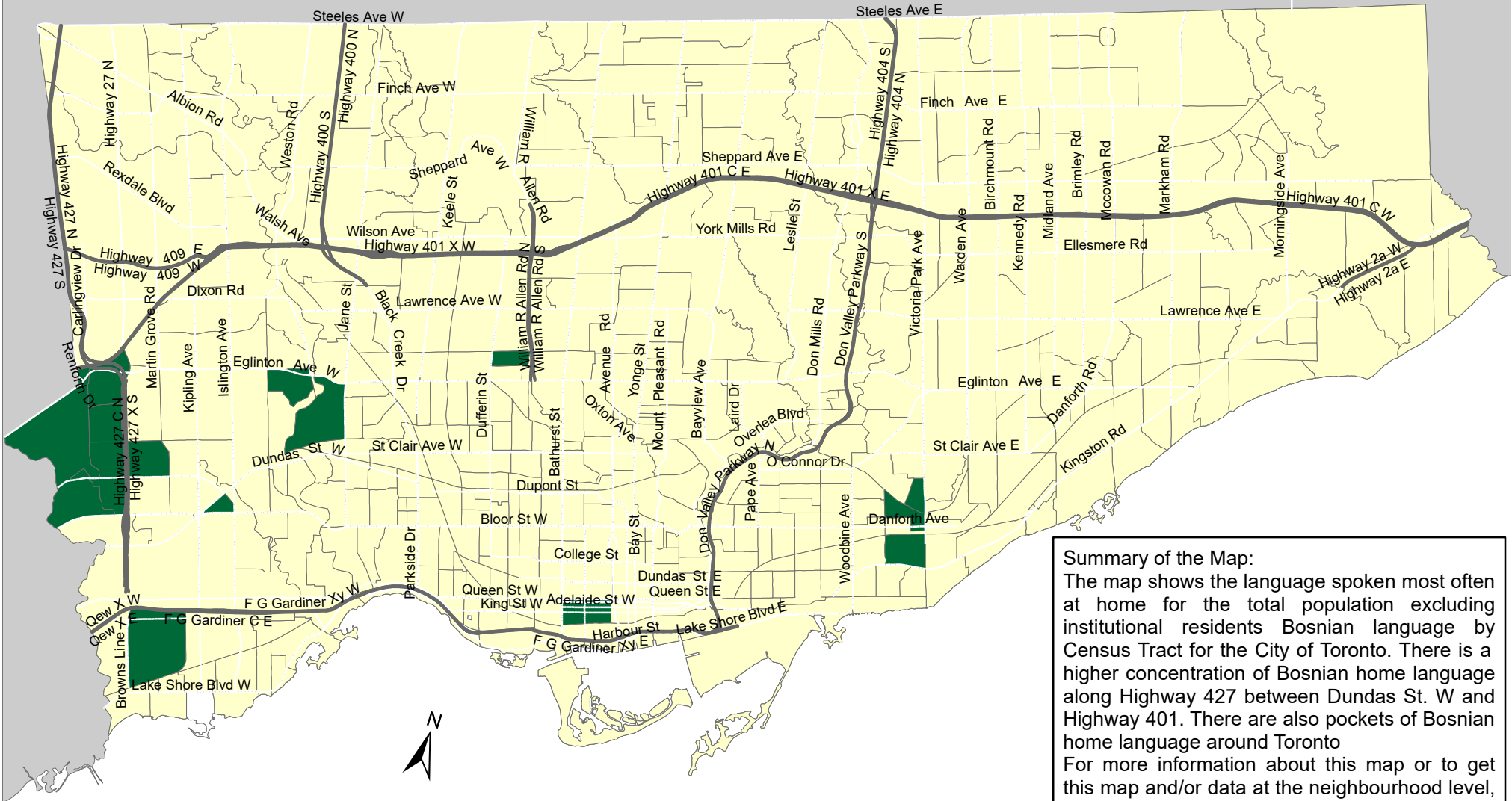


City of Toronto Home Language - Bosnian 2016
