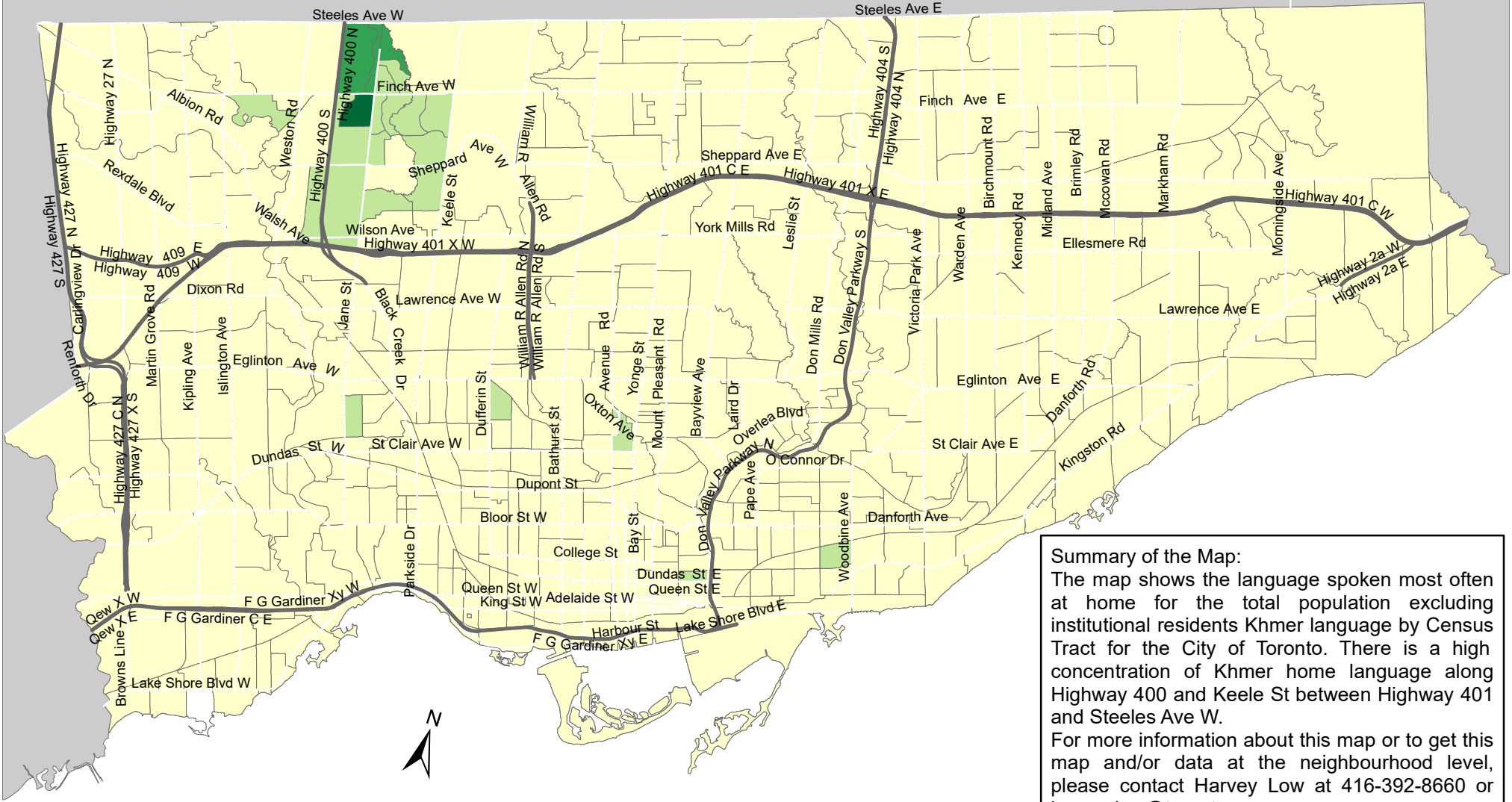


City of Toronto Home Language - Khmer 2016
