 The map shows the mother tongue for the total population excluding institutional residents Swahili language by Census Tract for the City of Toronto. There is a high concentration of Swahili mother tongue in the downtown region along Queen St E from Yonge St to the Don Valley Parkway. There are also several smaller concentrations scattered throughout the northwest region of the city.
