Summary:

Vine is by far the favourite concept. Features receiving most positive feedback include open lawn, area consolidating adult fitness/ping pong/games tables, long dining tables, and Piet Oudolf-style perennial gardens.

2. Flipchart notes:

Desired features include:

- ▶ Community garden
- ▶ Art installations, possibly integrated in the design
 - An interactive space
- ▶ Seniors/ accessibility a priority
- ▶ Open play
- ▶ Winter activities, i.e. skating
- ▶ Communal gathering space
- ▶ Meditation/quiet space
- ▶ Water fountain
- ▶ Solar-powered lighting
- ▶ Ground level lighting
- ▶ Rain shelter for eating
- ▶ Labyrinth

Issues

- ▶ Waste, from dining
- ▶ Park maintenance
- ▶ Traffic flow – children from school – speed on Ranleigh Ave
- ▶ Enclosure for Junior play
- ▶ Permitted activities / permits
- ▶ Interface between park and adjacent properties (perimeter fencing)
- ▶ Lighting – park safety - pollution

Ideas worth looking into include:

- ▶ Permitted activities / permits
- ▶ Fundraising opportunities
- ▶ Grants
