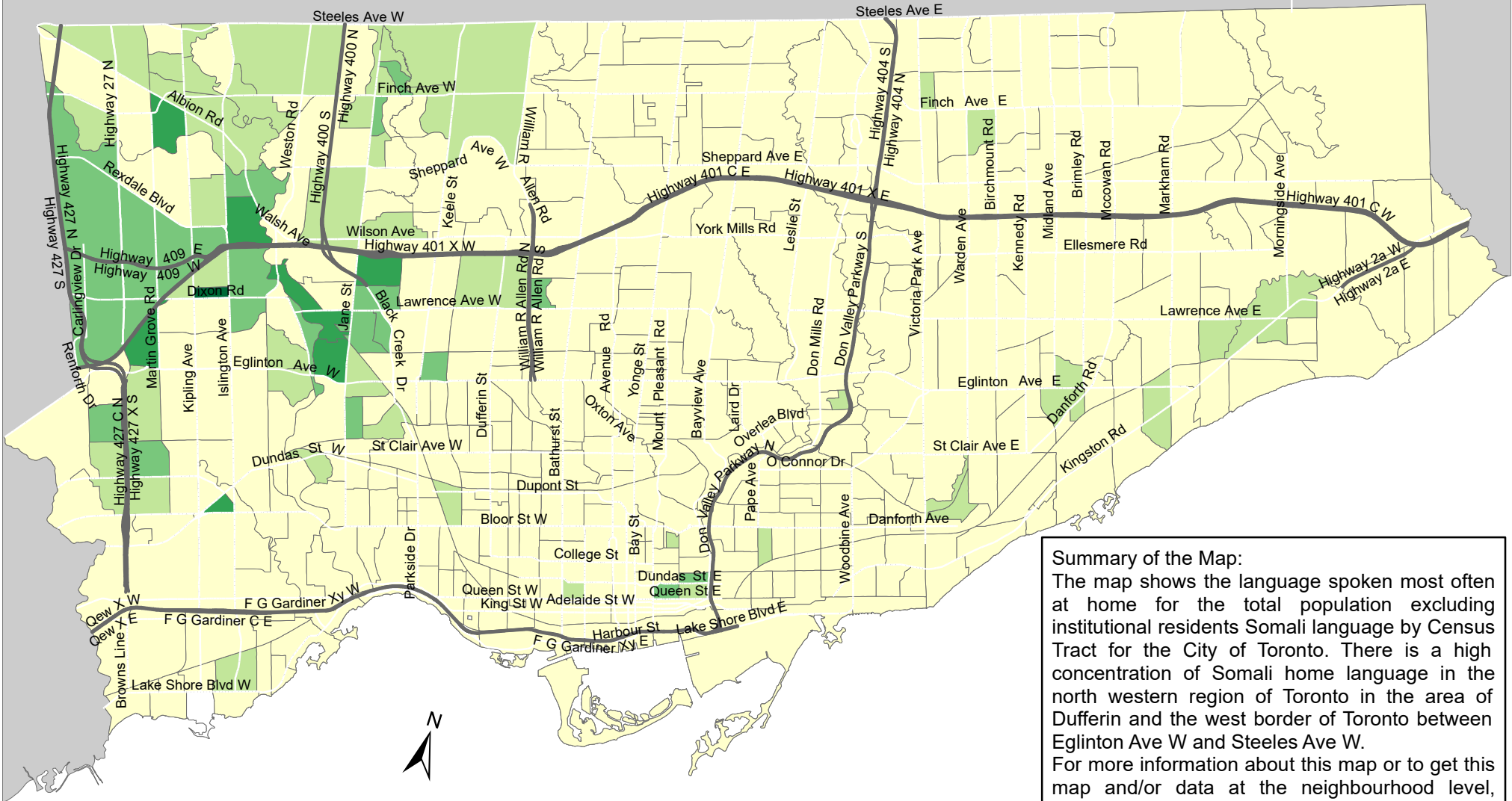


# City of Toronto Home Language - Somali 2016
