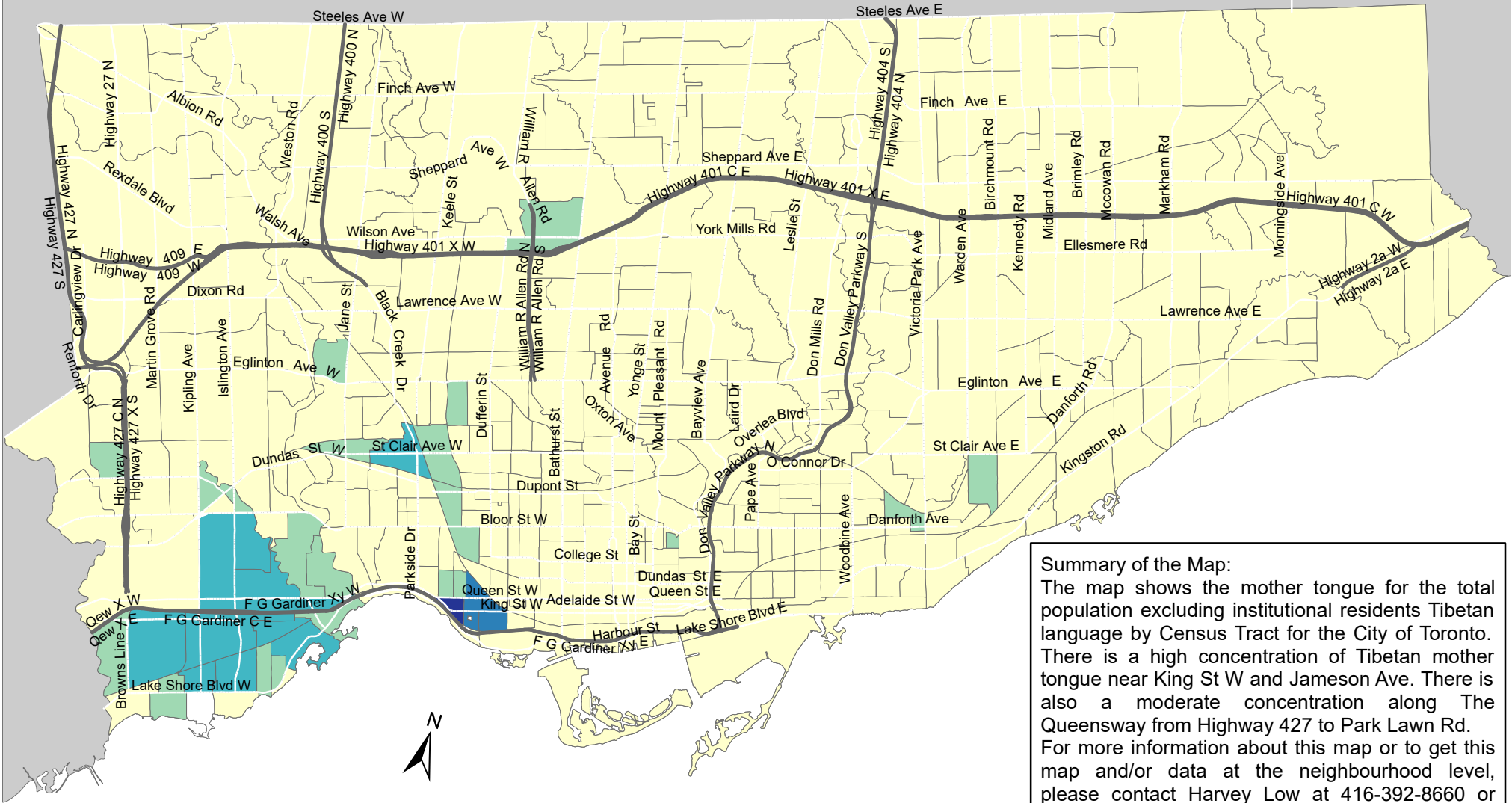
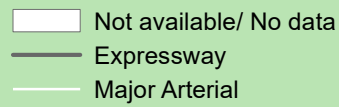
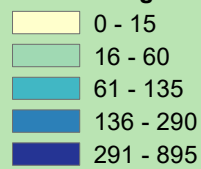


City of Toronto Mother Tongue - Tibetan 2016
