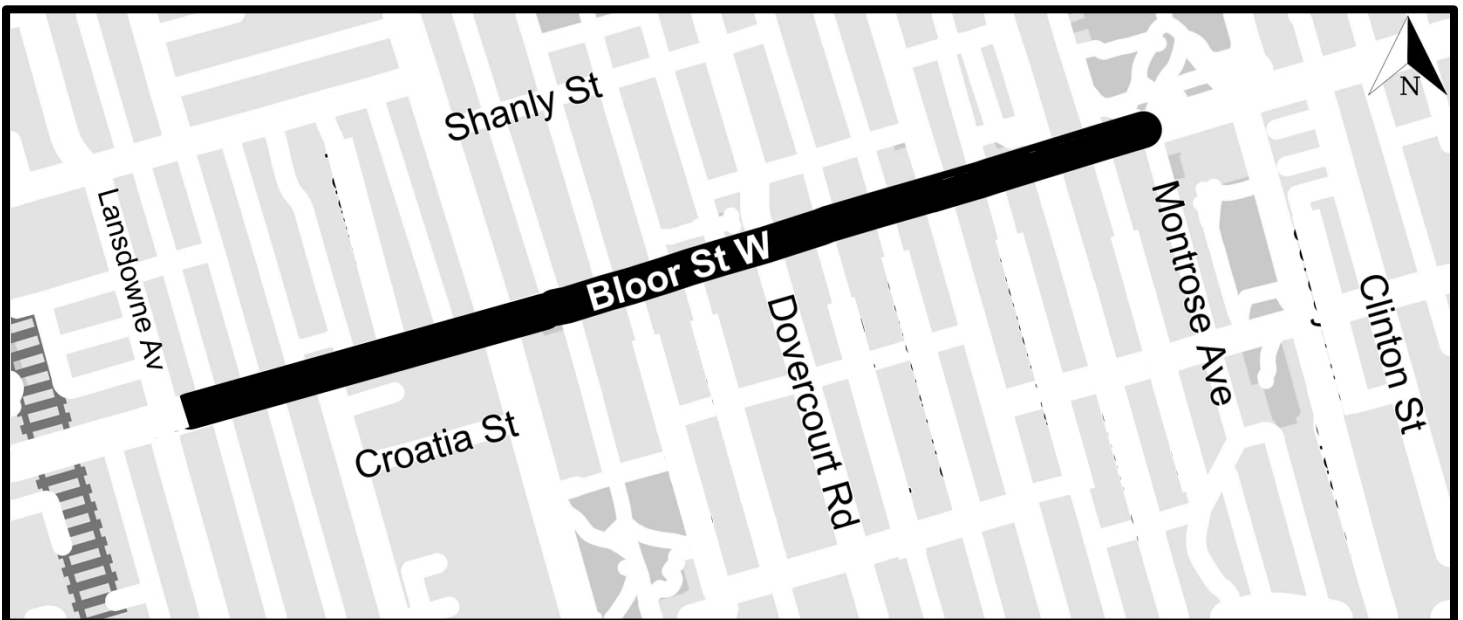

Earlier this week, the City of Toronto started completing repairs to small sections of curb and sidewalk on Bloor Street West from Lansdowne Avenue to Montrose Avenue.

This work will be scheduled and staged to reduce the impact to traffic and transit service. The City's contractor is completing this work as part of a warranty on previous construction work for the City. There is no cost to the City associated with this work.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will move along Bloor Street West to complete the necessary repairs to road, curbs and sidewalks.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with late evening and weekend work as required.</p>
	<p>Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Pedestrian and Driveway Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained on both sides of Bloor Street West. The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p>Lane restrictions will be required at isolated sections on Bloor Street.</p>
	<p>Parking: This project will not effect on parking or transit operations.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
