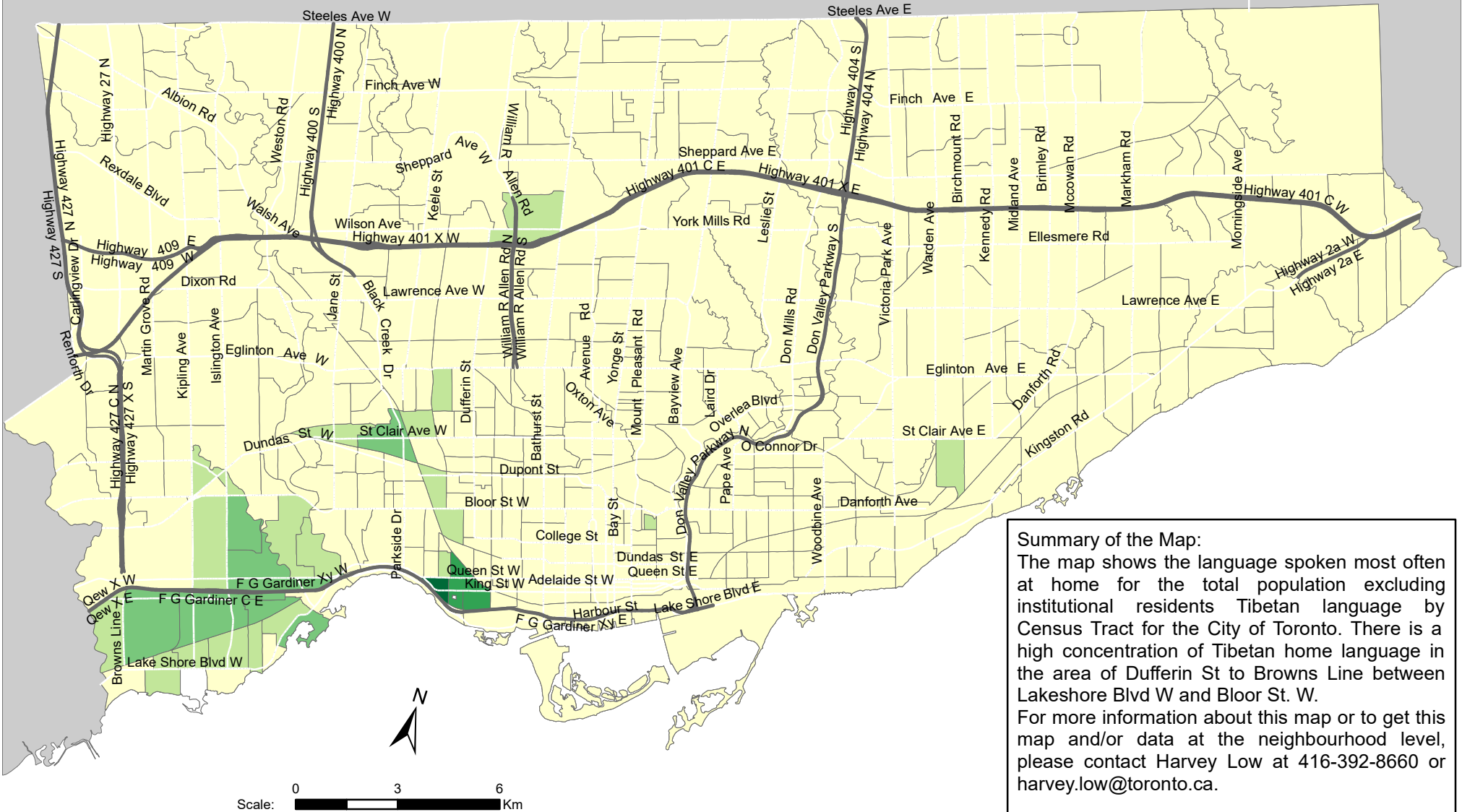


City of Toronto Home Language - Tibetan 2016
