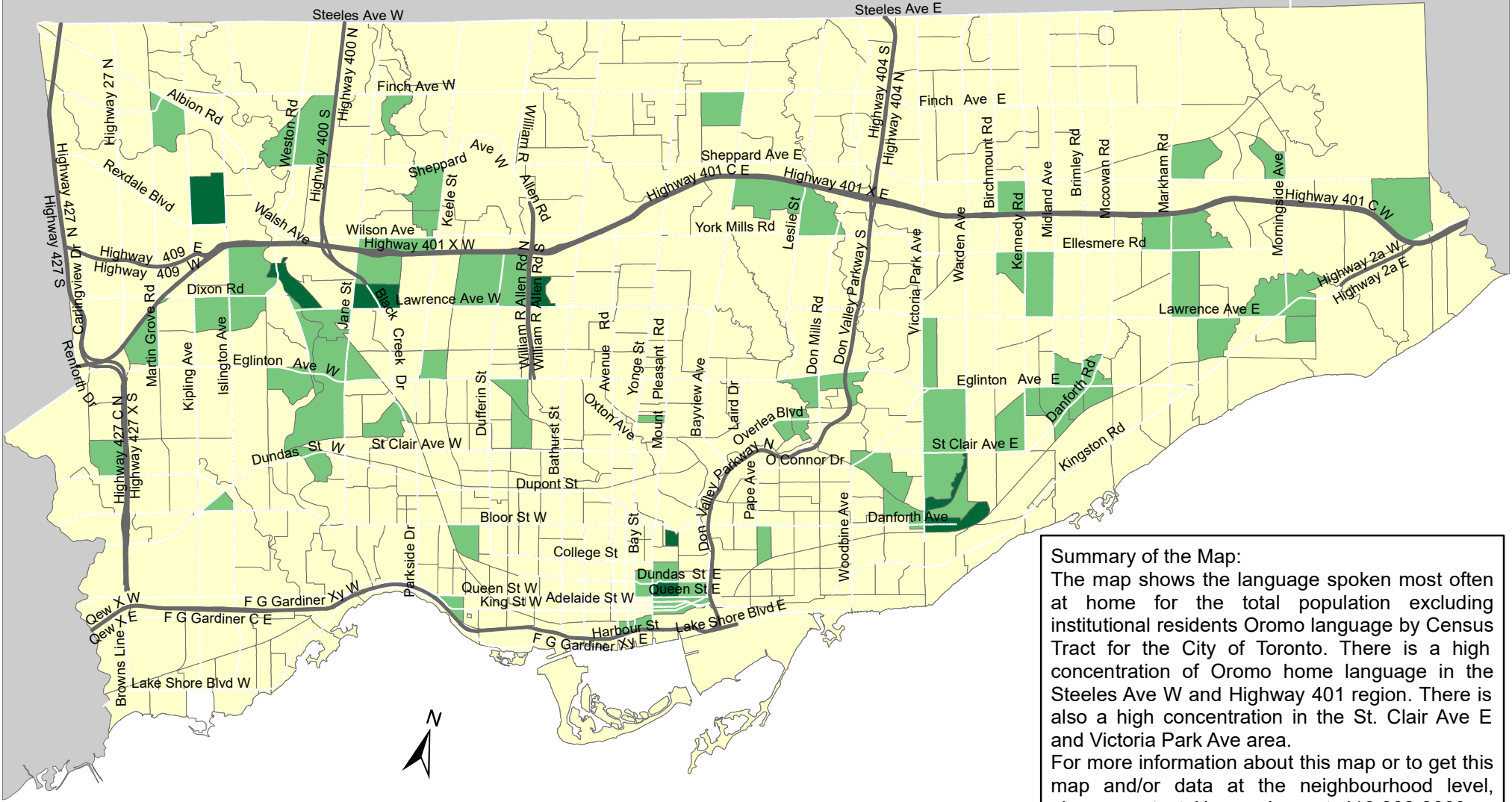
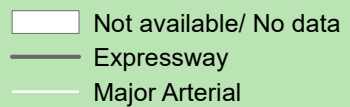
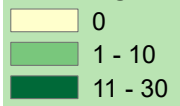


# City of Toronto Home Language - Oromo 2016
