

**OVERVIEW:**

- Through a shared leadership model, the Toronto Sport Resource Group (TSRG) will work collaboratively to successfully guide the implementation of the recommendations of the City of Toronto Sport Plan.
- In addition to City of Toronto staff, the TSRG will consist of up to 13 representatives from the following:
  - Organizations that work with diverse and racialized communities
  - Sport for Development Organizations
  - Boards of Education
  - Sports Councils
  - Research and Development Institutions
  - Private Individuals
- Suggested duration of membership: 24 months
- At a minimum, meetings will take place quarterly
- The City of Toronto Parks, Forestry and Recreation Division will have final approval on all recommended actions.
