## Glen Cedar Road Bridge Rehabilitation over Cedarvale Ravine

Expected End Date: September 2018

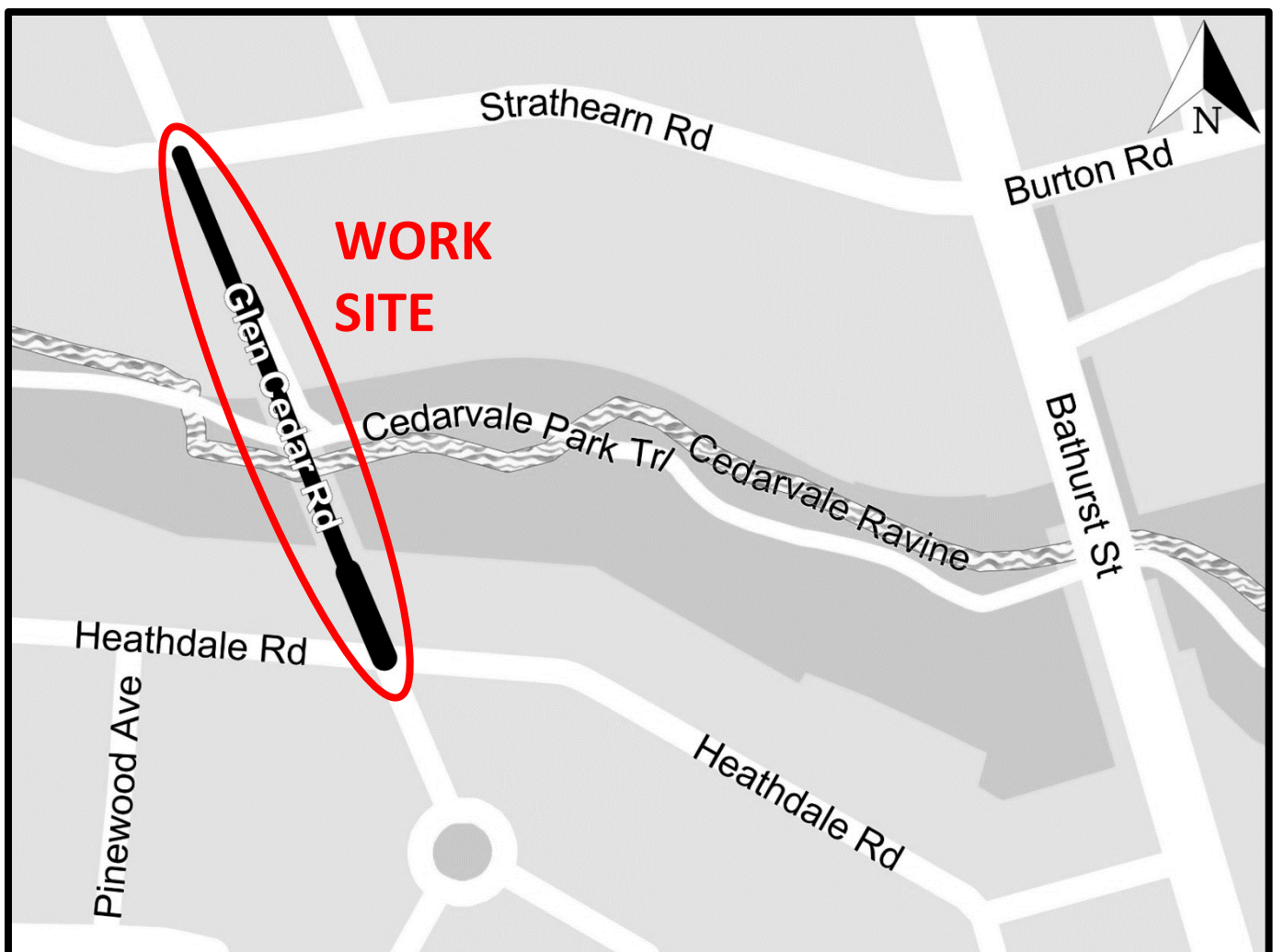

This notice serves as an update to the work taking place on the Glen Cedar Road Bridge over Cedarvale Ravine and the nearby staircase. On July 9 2018, the Contractor will begin the work on the staircase replacement, and continue to work on the walkway approaches and the bridge structure.

***In order to complete the work, the staircase will be closed with no access. Fencing will be in place to ensure residents and construction crews are safe.***

This work will ensure that the bridge and the staircase meets today's standards and remains safe for the public into the future.

### WORK DETAILS

To date, the contractor has started the following work:






- Replace the bridge deck and sidewalks of the bridge;
- Replace the railing and lighting system of the bridge;
- Clean and coat structural steel of the bridge; and
- Repair the piers and abutments of the bridge.

Beginning July 9, 2018, the contractor will begin the following work:

- Replace the northeast staircase.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The Contractor will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Bridge and Staircase Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be access restrictions within the construction work area including sections of the bridge.</p>
	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work on this project will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work will be performed after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Bridge Access:</b> Pedestrians will use the bridge alternating between the west and the east side of the bridge as the work progresses.</p> <p><b>Staircase Access:</b> Starting on July 9, there will be no access between the bridge and Cedarvale Park Trail</p> <p><b>Trail Safety:</b> On the Cedarvale Park Trail, pedestrians will use the hoarding system erected below the bridge.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Traffic should not be impacted by this work. Residents of the area may notice the presence of construction traffic (vehicles, materials, etc.) at Cedarvale Park and trail, and on Strathearn Road, Heathdale Road, Connaught Circle, and Glen Cedar Road.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
