The City of Toronto and Toronto Transit Commission will be renewing aging streetcar tracks at the intersection of Lansdowne and Dundas Street West. This is the second of three track replacement projects in recent years required for the Lansdowne/Dundas/College triangle. The intersection will be fully closed from September 3 to October 5. The City will also resurface Dufferin Street from Bloor Street to Dundas Street West.

This work is required to bring the track infrastructure and City's road to a state of good repair. These projects are part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program.

Around-the-clock work during rail installation by TTC is required to preserve the integrity and quality of new rail and concrete. Overnight rail work by TTC may consist of moving new rail into position, rail installation and rail welding / grinding.


