Road Resurfacing on Donlands Avenue from Mortimer Avenue to O'Connor Drive

Expected Start Date: August 13, 2018

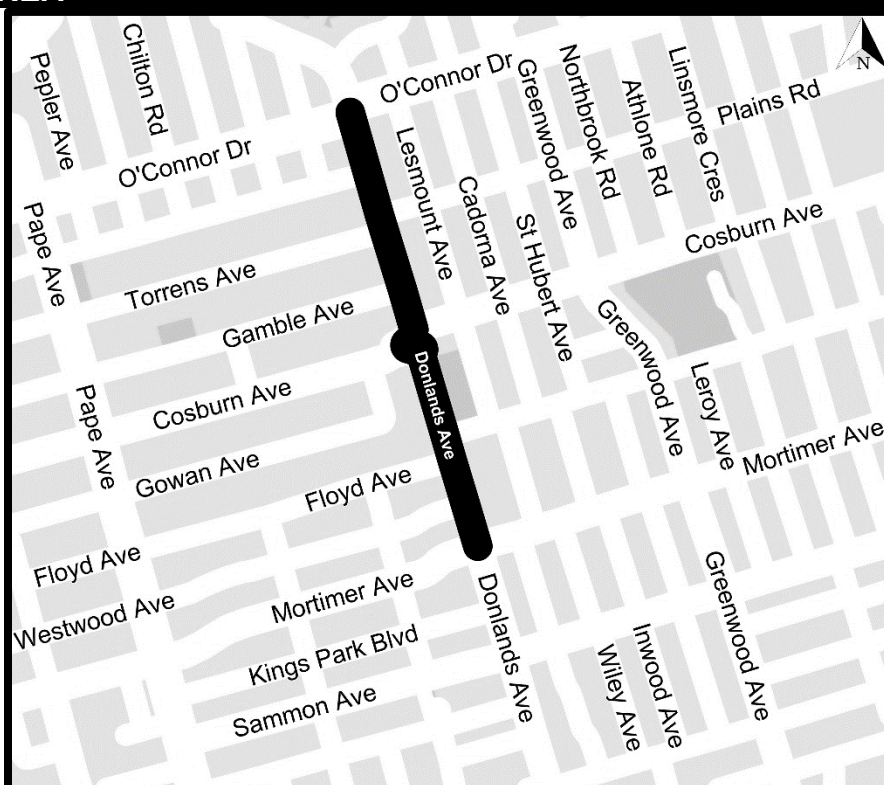
Expected End Date: December 21, 2018

The City of Toronto will resurface Donlands Avenue from Mortimer Avenue to O'Connor Drive. The work includes resurfacing the road, and replacing the curb and gutter on both sides of the road for the majority of the project area. Sections of concrete sidewalk will be replaced where required along Donlands Avenue.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS

City's contractor will:









- Dig up the road surface
- Replace the curb and gutter
- Replace sidewalk as required
- Re-align maintenance holes and catch basins
- Repave the road surface and restore areas affected by construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping, fencing, irrigation systems and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work on weekends as required.

	<p>Pre-Construction Inspection: Wristen's Home Specialties Inc. (WHS) under contract to the City of Toronto, will survey all properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Participation in the survey is voluntary; however, participating is important in determining if the construction caused damage. The inspection will look at both the interior and exterior of all properties to verify existing conditions. The company will deliver a separate notice requesting time to set up appointments. All inspection staff will be wearing photo identification and carrying photographic equipment during their work.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Donlands Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction within the work zone.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. <i>You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Field Ambassador does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.</i></p>
	<p>TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 56 Donlands Avenue bus. Visit ttc.ca for regular route schedule information.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.</p> <p><i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
