Watermain Replacement on Heath Street West from Lower Village Gate to Spadina Road

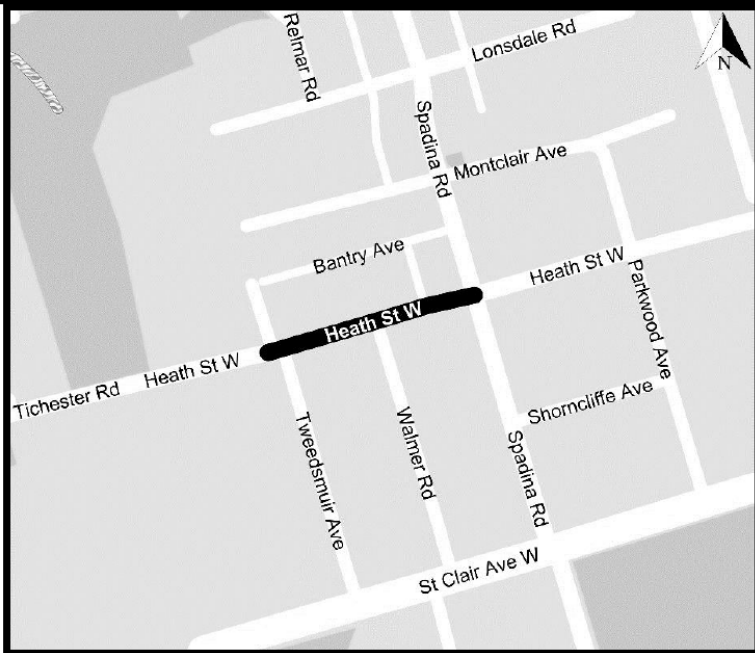

The City of Toronto has completed the watermain replacement project and will be finishing the restoration work including road resurfacing from Lower Village Gate to Spadina Road. This work will take place from **Thursday, August 2 2018 to Friday, August 3, 2018**. In order to complete this work safely, lane closures on Heath Street West will be required.

This project will be completed by August 7, 2018.

We appreciate your patience and understanding during this project and as we finish the restoration.

WORK UPDATE

To date the contractor has completed:


- Installing the watermain mainline,
- watermain connections between the new watermain and the existing watermain system,
- transferring water service connections onto the new watermain,
- restoring within the road, boulevard and sidewalk above the watermain and water services; and
- restoring the concrete within the intersection at Lower Village Gate and Heath Street West






The contractor will:

- resurface the road from the intersection of Lower Village Gate to Spadina Road.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, water shut-offs and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.
- The City will **not** be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
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	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Accommodation: Residents that require accommodation must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Heath Street will be reduced to one lane for the duration of construction activities.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>13K On-Street Parking Permit holders are asked to park elsewhere within the 13K parking zone (Heath Street West and Tichester Road from Bathurst Street to Spadina Road) to accommodate construction activity.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored. Only the portions of road dug for the watermain trench will be restored; road resurfacing (from curb to curb) is not part of this project.</p>
