New Sidewalk Construction on Gunns Road

Contract: 18ECS-TI-103LR Expected Start Date: Summer 2018 Expected End Date: Summer 2019

The City of Toronto is planning to construct 600m of new concrete sidewalk on the west and north side of Gunns Road from Tarragona Boulevard to Weston Road to complete the missing sidewalk link. Curb & gutter and concrete sidewalk will be replaced where required along Gunns Road.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program for additional sidewalks for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes
 removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where
 necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard area), such as landscaping, fencing, irrigation systems and / or decorative objects before work starts. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property.

Ŀ	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.
8 - - - - - - - - - - - - 	Access to Your Home / Property: The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.
