# Walkway Reconstruction from Queens Drive to Maple Leaf Drive west of Culford Road


Contract: 18ECS-TI-103LR

The City of Toronto is planning to reconstruct the walkway from Queens Drive to Maple Leaf Drive 184 m west of Culford Road. Our inspection of the walkway shows that it needs reconstruction to bring it to a state of good repair.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew aging city walkway for current and future needs.

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#### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins
  with more information about the work.
- This work includes removing and replacing fences and grassed areas, where necessary. Some trees will also be removed.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits of the walkway before
  work starts. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City
  property.



**Access to Your Home:** The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.
