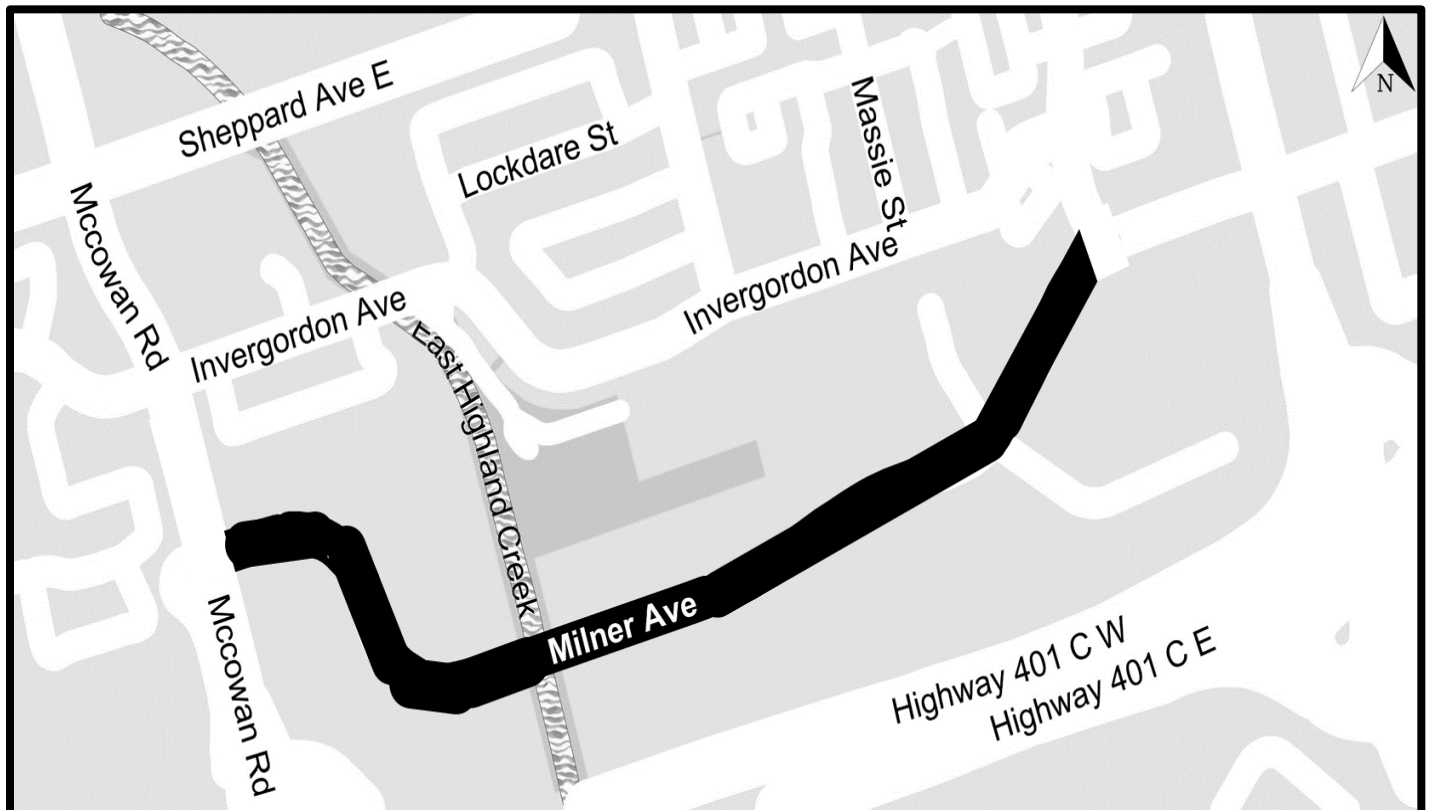

The City of Toronto will construct a new sidewalk on Milner Avenue from McCowan Road to Scunthorpe Road. The work involves constructing a new sidewalk, as well as curb and gutter at localized locations, on the north side of Milner Avenue.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to provide sidewalk for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS

Stage 1 work - August 13 to August 31, 2018

The City's contractor will:




- Mobilize preparing for sidewalk construction
- Install tree protection and remove 64 small street trees from the City's boulevard for new sidewalk
- Replace Fire Hydrants






Stage 2 work - September 24 to November 16, 2018

- Construct a new sidewalk on the north side
- Replace the curb and gutter as required
- Restore areas affected by construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping, fencing, irrigation systems and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Milner Avenue will be reduced to one lane eastbound within the work zone, as required.</p>

	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. <i>You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Field Ambassador does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.</i></p>
	<p>TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 132 Milner Avenue bus. Visit ttc.ca for regular route schedule information.</p>
	<p>City Owned Trees: due to the nature of this project, the City will have to remove 64 small street trees from the City's boulevard. For street trees removed, for the work, the City will plant a replacement tree of at least 60mm in diameter. Trees in the removal area will be replaced and overseen by the City's Parks, Recreation & Forestry Division in the near future.</p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
