Road Resurfacing on Eastern Avenue from Knox Avenue to Marigold Avenue



The City of Toronto is planning to resurface the road on Eastern Avenue from Knox Avenue to Marigold Avenue. Our inspection of the road shows that it needs repaving and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins
 with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveway aprons, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager listed below.

| 8 | Traffic Management : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. |
| Ð | One lane of vehicular traffic in each direction will be maintained on Eastern Avenue at all times. No work is scheduled on Leslie Street. |
| GTO | Cyclists: Temporary closures of the cycling lanes on Eastern Avenue from Marigold Avenue to Leslie Street will be required. Advanced signage will be used to inform cyclist to merge with traffic. |
| | TTC Service: TTC buses will continue to serve Eastern Avenue. Temporary stop changes may be required depending on lane and sidewalk restrictions. |
| ×. | Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. |
| 71 | Sidewalks along Eastern Avenue will remain accessible and pedestrians will be safely detoured around the work area to access local businesses. |
| . | Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. |
