## Watermain Replacement & Road Resurfacing on Dundas Street West from Bathurst Street to Bay Street

**Contract: 18ECS-TI-03SP**

**Start Date: Fall 2018**

**End Date: Fall 2019**

*\*Content/dates subject to change. More details will be provided in a future notice.*

The City of Toronto will replace the watermain and City-owned substandard water services on Dundas Street West between Spadina Avenue and Bay Street. The City will also be reconstructing the intersections at Carlyle Street and Casimir Street and repairing road and sidewalks impacted by previous utility works. The road will be resurfaced where watermain work is taking place.

This coordinated project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk of watermain breaks. Work on this project is phased over the rest of 2018 and will use most of the construction season in 2019. (see map on page 4 and details below).

## WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable.
- A Construction notice confirming the start date and more details of the work will be delivered to affected properties approximately 1-2 weeks prior to the start of the project.
- Work in the boulevards in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. Property owners must remove items located within City property limits (boulevard).
- You will experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Most of this work will take place Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. <b>Note</b> - Road work and water service connection work may take place <b>outside</b> of these hours</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Information:</b> Motorists are reminded to abide by signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians and cyclists.</p> <p><b>Dundas St. W. within the work zones will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction.</b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at <b>416-808-2222</b>.</p>
	<p><b>Public Parking:</b> Access to public parking lots around the work zone will be maintained.</p>
	<p><b>505 Dundas buses</b> will operate on Dundas Street West but the construction may affect travel times <b>Visit: <a href="http://ttc.ca">ttc.ca</a> for accurate schedule and routing information.</b></p>

	<p><b>Pre-Construction Inspection:</b> The Contractor plans to survey all properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Participation in the survey is voluntary; however, participating is important in determining if the construction caused damage. The inspection will look at both the interior and exterior of all properties to verify existing conditions. The company will deliver a separate notice requesting time to set up appointments. All inspection staff will be wearing photo identification and carrying photographic equipment during their work.</p>
	<p><b>Water Service Disruptions:</b> From time-to-time, the water supply to your property will be shut-off to complete construction; the Contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not received advanced notice, an <b>emergency water shut off</b> could have been necessary.</p>
  	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access: Sidewalks along Dundas Street will remain accessible and pedestrians will be able to safely detour around the work area to access local businesses.</b></p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The Contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Laneways:</b> The Contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to any Laneways.</p> <p><b>Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation must contact the project manager to arrange for access during construction through the contacts below.</p>
	<p><b>Deliveries:</b> Businesses may want to consider adjusting delivery times or use an alternate entrance as a result of the lane restrictions during this project.</p>
	<p><b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please follow your normal routine and place your garbage according to the normal schedule. If required, the Contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <b>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address. The Contractor will not be responsible for garbage if you miss the normal pick up schedule.</b></p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
	<p><b>Businesses</b> will be open throughout construction. All are welcome to dine and shop.</p>
