# Road Resurfacing and Sidewalk Replacement on Glenholme Avenue from Rogers Road to Genessee Avenue



The City of Toronto is planning to resurface the road and replace the curb and sidewalk on Glenholme Avenue from Rogers Road to just north of Genessee Avenue. Our inspection of the road shows that it needs repaving and curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

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### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins
  with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard area), such as landscaping, fencing, irrigation systems and / or decorative objects before work starts. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property.



**Accessible Accommodation:** Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the **Field Ambassador** to arrange for access during the construction period.



**Access to Your Home:** The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.
