New Sidewalk Construction on Tedder Street and Thurodale Avenue

Expected Start Date: Summer 2018

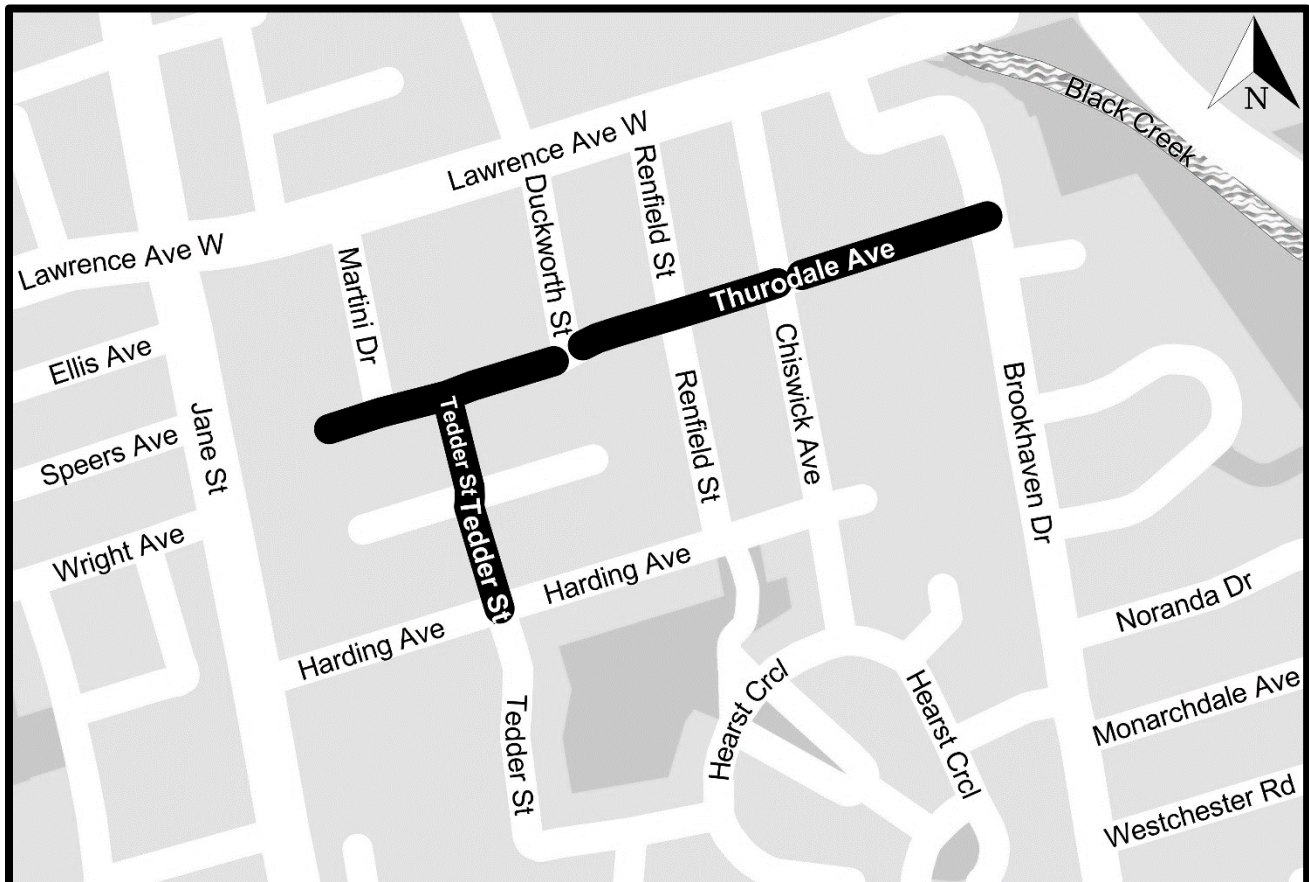

The City of Toronto is planning to build 180 m of new concrete sidewalk and replace the curb where required on the west side of Tedder Street from Harding Avenue to Thurodale Avenue. On Thurodale Avenue, the City will build a new curb bump-out at Chiswick Avenue, build 510m of new concrete sidewalk and replace necessary curbs on the north side of Thurodale Avenue.



This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program for additional sidewalks for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard area), such as landscaping, fencing, irrigation systems and / or decorative objects before work starts. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Access to Your Home / Property: The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.</p>
