Phases 1 & 2: Watermain Replacement & Road Resurfacing on Dundas Street West from Bathurst Street to Simcoe Street

Contract: 18ECS-TI-03SP
Start Date: September 24, 2018
End Date: Spring 2019

**Content/dates subject to change. More details will be provided in a future notice.*

The City of Toronto will replace the watermain and City-owned substandard water services on Dundas Street West between Spadina Avenue and Simcoe Street. The road will be resurfaced where watermain work is taking place. The City will also be reconstructing the intersections at Carlyle Street and Casimir Street and repairing road and sidewalks impacted by previous utility works on Dundas Street West between Casimir Street and Kensington Avenue.

This coordinated project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk of watermain breaks. (see map on page 4 and details below).

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Work Hours: Most of this work will take place Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.</p> <p>Note - Road work and water service connection work may take place outside of these hours</p>
	<p>Traffic Information: Motorists are reminded to abide by signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians and cyclists.</p> <p>Dundas St. W. within the work zones will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction.</p>
	<p>Public Parking: Access to public parking lots around the work zone will be maintained.</p>
	<p>505 Dundas buses will operate on Dundas Street West but the construction may affect travel times Visit: ttc.ca for accurate schedule and routing information.</p>
	<p>Boulevard Work: Work in the boulevard in front of homes and business will be required to accommodate sidewalk construction, and watermain work.</p> <p>Property owners in the affected area are reminded to remove any privately owned items and encroachments from the boulevard. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.</p>
  	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: Sidewalks along Dundas Street will remain accessible and pedestrians will be able to safely detour around the work area to access local businesses.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The Contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Laneways: The Contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to any Laneways.</p> <p>Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation must contact the project manager to arrange for access during construction through the contacts below.</p>
	<p>Deliveries: Businesses may want to consider adjusting delivery times or use an alternate entrance as a result of the lane restrictions during this project.</p>

	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine and place your garbage according to the normal schedule. If required, the Contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address. The Contractor will not be responsible for garbage if you miss the normal pick up schedule.</i> Further information will be provided to affected properties.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
	<p>Businesses will be open throughout construction. All are welcome to dine and shop.</p>
