Coxwell Sanitary Trunk Sewer Odour Control Study

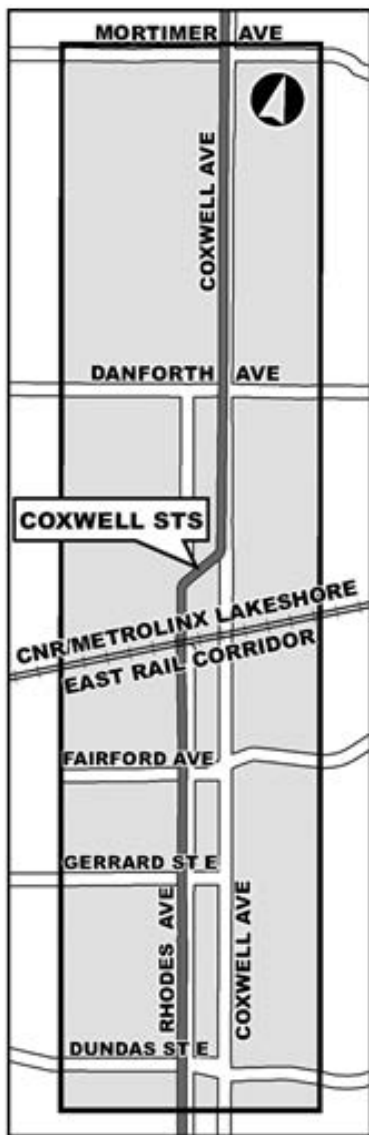
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Notice of Study Commencement

Background

The Coxwell Sanitary Trunk Sewer is located beneath Coxwell Avenue and Rhodes Avenue, carrying sewage to the Ashbridges Bay Wastewater Treatment Plant. The City of Toronto has received sewer odour complaints from residents in the vicinity of the Coxwell STS, near the intersection of Rhodes Avenue and Fairford Avenue, and near the intersection of Rhodes Avenue and Dundas Street East. This study will define the problem and opportunities, develop and evaluate alternative solutions, assess impacts of the preferred solution, and identify mitigation measures to lessen any adverse impacts. **The Class EA process provides members of the public and interested parties with opportunities to provide input at key stages of the study. Notification of public events will be advertised in the local newspaper and notices mailed to residents and businesses within the study area.**
