1. Completed application form (Parts A & B)
 - a) Only eligible heritage conservation work must be included in Part B Statement of Proposed Conservation Work;
 - b) Each component of the Proposed Conservation Work must be listed separately with three separate estimates for each
2. Cost estimates for each component of the Proposed Conservation Work must be accompanied by a detailed description prepared by a qualified architect, restoration consultant or contractor demonstrating how each component of the proposed conservation work will be undertaken and should include specifications and/or architectural drawings (where relevant).
3. Recent photographs (colour, no smaller than 6x4") and digital images (minimum 300 dpi) which provide an overall view of the exterior.
4. Recent photographs and digital images (as above) which clearly illustrate the areas of the building that are the subject of the proposed conservation work.
5. Signed copy of the City of Toronto's Declaration of a Non-Discrimination Policy.

Successful recipients may receive one Toronto Heritage Grant every five years for any given heritage property. Owners of multiple properties are eligible to apply for a grant for only one property each year.
