Bridge Rehabilitation Neilson Road Bridge South of Finch Avenue East

Contract: 18ECS-TI-02BE Expected Start Date: September 2018* Expected End Date: May 2019* *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the Neilson Road Bridge, south of Finch Avenue East, in 2018-2019. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program.



WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Repair the deck and underside of the Neilson Road Bridge
- Replace the sidewalks and barrier walls of the Neilson Road Bridge

Construction will take place in two stages:

Stage	Dates	Work	Traffic Management
1	September – December	Work will take place on the north and south outer portions of the bridge.	One lane of traffic in each direction will be provided on the middle lanes of the bridge not under construction.
2	January – May	Work will take place on the middle portions of the bridge. Final asphalt paving will occur in the Spring.	One lane of traffic in each direction will be provided on the north and south outer lanes of the bridge not under construction.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours : Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
÷	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. At least one sidewalk along Neilson Road will be open at all times.
8	Traffic Management: One lane of Neilson Road will be closed in each direction for the duration of construction. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.
	TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 133 Neilson Bus.

	Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.
