## Road Resurfacing on Arnall Avenue and other local roads

**Contract: 18ECS-TI-15LR**

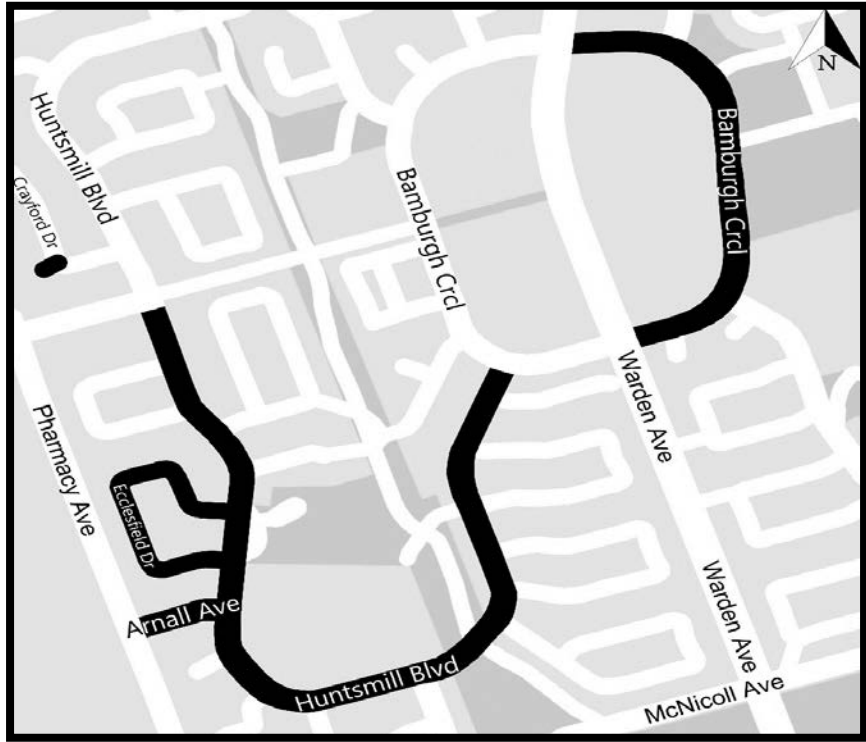
**Start Date: July 30, 2018**

**End Date: October 30, 2018**

*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto will resurface the road on Arnall Avenue, Bamburgh Circle, Crayford Drive, Ecclesfield Drive and Huntsmill Boulevard (see map). Our inspection of the road shows that it needs resurfacing and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair. This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

### WORK DETAILS

- The City's contractor will:
- Dig up the road surface
  - Re-align maintenance holes and catch basins
  - Repair curbs, gutters and driveways
  - Repave the road surface

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and/or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Field Ambassador.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. <b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
	<b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers and road users. <b>Traffic will be reduced during active construction, access may be limited when paving operations are taking place.</b>
	<b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at <b>416-808-2222</b> .  In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. <b>You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Field Ambassador does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.</b>
	<b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <b>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</b>
	<b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).

### ASBESTOS IN ASPHALT

Asbestos was used in asphalt mixes throughout the 1970s and early 1980s to improve the performance of the asphalt. The City must test the removed asphalt to be removed for asbestos. Our tests show that there is **2%** of asbestos in the asphalt. Air quality monitoring conducted by the City of Toronto at other sites has not detected asbestos fibres in the air as a result of resurfacing of asphalt. The risk of exposure to asbestos for workers and bystanders is low.

#### As a precaution, the City's contractor will follow these steps:

- Wet the pavement during asphalt cutting, grinding or removal
- Attach dust collecting devices with HEPA filters to equipment, where possible, to prevent dust from becoming airborne
- Provide personal protective equipment, such as disposable coveralls and respirators, to on-site workers upon request, and
- Transport and dispose of asphalt containing asbestos at provincially approved disposal sites.

## 路面重铺 - 阿诺大道 (Arnall Avenue) 和其他局部道路

 开始日期: 2018年7月30日  
 结束日期: 2018年10月30日

多市市政府将重新铺阿诺大道 (Arnall Avenue)、百宝径 (Bamburgh Circle)、克雷福德路 (Crayford Drive)、厄克斯菲路 (Ecclesfield Drive) 和亨茨米大道 (Huntsmill Boulevard) 的路面 (铺地)。我们上述路段铺地后，保持了道路的良好状况，路面需要重铺，部分坏的路口和人行道需要更新。这项工作是由市议会批准的2018年基建工程计划中的一部分，旨在更新老化的城市道路和人行道以满足当前及未来的需求。







### 具体施工步骤

市政府承包商将:

- 挖掘路面
- 重新修整孔和路口集水池
- 修复路口、沟槽及水道
- 重铺路面

### 施工期间会怎样

- 您可能会遇到粉尘、噪音和其他不便。市政府将努力减少一些不利影响。我们感谢您的耐心。
- 请主移除市政府界限 (道路) 内的物品，如景观和/或装饰品。如果您在道路范围内安装了洒水系统，请联系 (Field Ambassador)。市政府产生的在市界内的私有物品损坏概不负责。

	<b>工作时间:</b> 工作日上午 7:00 至晚 7:00，周一至周五，必要时也会加班或在周末工作。
	<b>道路和人行道的使用:</b> 为了施工安全，将限制使用施工区内的道路和人行道，但紧急情况可随路通行。 <b>私人道路的使用:</b> 如果需要限制使用您的私人道路，承包商将通知。如果您的物业有两个入口，其中一个入口将始终保持开放。
	<b>交通管理:</b> 为了工人、道路使用者和居民的安全，我们将尽力管控好该地区的交通。 <b>正在施工的街道的交通量将减少/铺设路面时可能需要限制进入。</b>
	<b>停车:</b> 施工区和材料需占用一定空间，因此施工区内不准停车。如果您停放的车辆影响到施工，您的车将被移至安全区域。如果您的车被移走，请致电 <b>416-808-2222</b> 向停车管理部门报告。如果您在此施工期间收到有关路口停车的交通通知，您可以按照通知背面列出的程序提出申诉。 <b>在施工期间，您可以使用此通知作为您在施工期间在此停车的抗辩；但Field Ambassador) 无法取消任何停车。</b>
	<b>垃圾与回收:</b> 请按照正常规划进行。如有需要，承包商会将垃圾桶或回收桶移至适当位置，之后再移回原位。 <b>请在垃圾桶上注明您的地址。</b>
	<b>恢复:</b> 如有需要，施工区域将使用草皮和/或青苔进行恢复。在施工期间从公共和私人物业移除的碎石基上的石板或其他类似结构将被重新安置。根据需要将在理想的生长期 - 春季 (4月至6月) 和秋季 (9月至10月) 播种草籽和/或草皮。

### 青苔中的石棉

作为工程的一部分，市政府必须移除之青苔中的石棉含量。我们的测试表明，一些青苔中含有 2% 的石棉，低于工部的关注水平。在 20 世纪 70 年代以及 80 年代初期，青苔混合物中会使用石棉来改善青苔的性能。多市市政府其他地点进行的空气量测试没有显示重青苔路面会造成空气中石棉含量。工人和路人接触石棉的风险很低。

作为预防措施，市政府承包商将遵循以下步骤:

- 在青苔切割、研磨或移除的过程中在路面上洒水
- 在可能的情况下，在路口上安装带有 HEPA 过滤器的集尘装置，以防止粉尘入空气
- 要求所有工作人员提供个人防护，如一次性工作服和呼吸器等
- 将含有石棉的青苔运至安省批准的处置所进行处理。
