

Road Resurfacing on Arnall Avenue and other local roads

Contract: 18ECS-TI-15LR Start Date: July 30, 2018 End Date: October 30, 2018 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will resurface the road on Arnall Avenue, Bamburgh Circle, Crayford Drive, Ecclesfield Drive and Huntsmill Boulevard (see map). Our inspection of the road shows that it needs resurfacing and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair. This work is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Dig up the road surface
- Re-align maintenance holes and catch basins
- Repair curbs, gutters and driveways
- Repave the road surface

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and/or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Field Ambassador.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers and road users.

Traffic will be reduced during active construction, access may be limited when paving operations are taking place.



Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at **416-808-2222**.

In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Field Ambassador does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.



Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. *Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.*



Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).

ASBESTOS IN ASPHALT

Asbestos was used in asphalt mixes throughout the 1970s and early 1980s to improve the performance of the asphalt. The City must test the removed asphalt to be removed for asbestos. Our tests show that there is 2% of asbestos in the asphalt. Air quality monitoring conducted by the City of Toronto at other sites has not detected asbestos fibres in the air as a result of resurfacing of asphalt. The risk of exposure to asbestos for workers and bystanders is low.

As a precaution, the City's contractor will follow these steps:

- Wet the pavement during asphalt cutting, grinding or removal
- Attach dust collecting devices with HEPA filters to equipment, where possible, to prevent dust from becoming airborne
- Provide personal protective equipment, such as disposable coveralls and respirators, to on-site workers upon request, and
- Transport and dispose of asphalt containing asbestos at provincially approved disposal sites.

多□多市政府将重新□□阿□□大道(Arnall Avenue)、百宝径(Bamburgh Circle)、克雷福德路(Crayford Drive)、厄克斯菲路(Ecclesfield Drive)和亨茨米□大道(Huntsmill Boulevard)的路面(□地□)。我□□上述路段□□后□□,□了□持道路的良好状□,路面需要重□,部分□坏的路□和人行道需要更□。 这项工作是市议会批准的2018年基建工程计划中的一部分,旨在更新老化的城市道路和人行道以满足当前及未来的需求。

具体施工步口

市政府承包商将:

- 挖掘路面
- 重新□整□修孔和路□集水池

- 修复路□、沟槽及□道
- 重□路面

施工期口口期会怎口

- 您可能会□□粉□、噪音和其他不便。市政府将努力减少□些不利影响。我□感□您的耐心。
- □主□移除市政府□□界限(道路)内的物品,如景□和/或装□品。如果您在道路范□内安装了洒水系□,□□系□□□□□(Field Ambassador)。市政府□□生在市府□□界限内的私有物品□坏概不□□。



工作□□:工作□□□早 7:00 至晚 7:00,周一至周五,必要□也会加班或在周末工作。



道路和人行道的使用:□了施工安全,将限制使用施工区内的道路和人行道,但□急□□可随□通行。

私人口道的使用:如果需要□□限制使用您的私人□道,承包商将□出通知。如果您的物□有两个入口,其中一个入口将始□保持开放。



交通管理:为了工人、道路使用者和居民的安全,我们将尽力管控好该地区的交通。 **正在施工的街道的交通量将减少/铺设路面时可能需要限制进入。**



停□:施工□□和材料需占用一定空□,因此施工区内不准停□。如果您停放的□□影响到施工,您的□将被免□移至□□。如果您的□被移走,□致□ 416-808-2222 向停□管理部□□□。 如果您在此施工期□收到有关路□停□的交通□□,您可以□□按照停□□□通知背面列出的程序□□□提出异□。 *在施工期□,您可以使用此通知作□您在施工期□在此停□的抗□□据;但□□□□□(Field Ambassador)无□取消任何□□停□□□。*



垃圾与回收:□按照正常□划□行。如有需要,承包商会将垃圾桶或回收桶移至适当位置,□后再移回原□。*□一定在垃圾桶上□明您的地址。*



恢复:如有需要,施工区域将使用草皮和/或□青□行恢复。在施工期□从公共和私人物□移除的□□□、碎石基□上的石板或其他□似□ 构将被重新安置。根据需要将在理想的生□季□ - 春季(4 月至 6 月)和秋季(9 月至 10 月)播种草籽和/或□□草皮。

□青中的石棉

作□工程的一部分,市政府必□□□待移除之□青中的石棉含量。我□的□□表明,□些□青中含有 2%的石棉,低于□工□的关注水平。 在 20 世 □ 70 年代以及 80 年代初期,□青混合料中会使用石棉来改善□青的性能。多□多市政府□其他地点□行的空气□量□□没有□□重□□青路面会造成空气中出□石棉□□。工人和路人接触石棉的□□很低。

作口口防措施, 市政府承包商将遵循以下步口:

- 在□青切割、研磨或移除的□程中在路面上洒水
- 在可能的情况下,在□□上安装□有 HEPA □□器的集□装置
 - ,以防止粉口口入空气

- □要求□□□工作人□提供个人防□□□,如一次性工作服和 呼吸器等
- 将含有石棉的□青运至安省批准的□置□所□行□理。
