Introduction

All dates and requirements are subject to change. Evaluation dates selected by the candidate on a per stage basis are considered final. All candidates must participate in each selection stage.

You will be receiving emails from addresses using the following domains: @toronto.ca, @eventbrite.com, and @checkmarket.com. It is suggested that you favorite these domains and keywords to minimize the likelihood of filtering to your spam or junk folders.

Candidates will receive an email from <u>paramedic.careers@toronto.ca</u> following every *successful* stage. This email will indicate which documentation to submit for the upcoming stage, will provide links to forms if needed, and will provide links for submission of documentation. These emails will also invite you to schedule an appointment for your next testing stage. You are expected to submit the electronic documentation *at least* 24 hours in advance of your chosen evaluation date.

Candidates who are offered conditional employment following Stage 4 will be required to successfully complete a 2-day orientation and evaluation (or equivalency) with the Sunnybrook Centre for Prehospital Medicine. Additional administrative dates will occur during this time.

Conditional employment offers are expected to occur the week of March 11th and March 25th, 2019. There are currently two classes scheduled to commence on April 23rd, 2019 (Class 1) and June 4th, 2019 (Class 2). The Orientation process consists of both an in-class portion during normal business hours (approximately 3 weeks) and a 6-week field mentorship portion (12 hour shifts).
