Retaining Wall Rehabilitation along Mount Pleasant Road

Expected Start Date: October 24, 2018

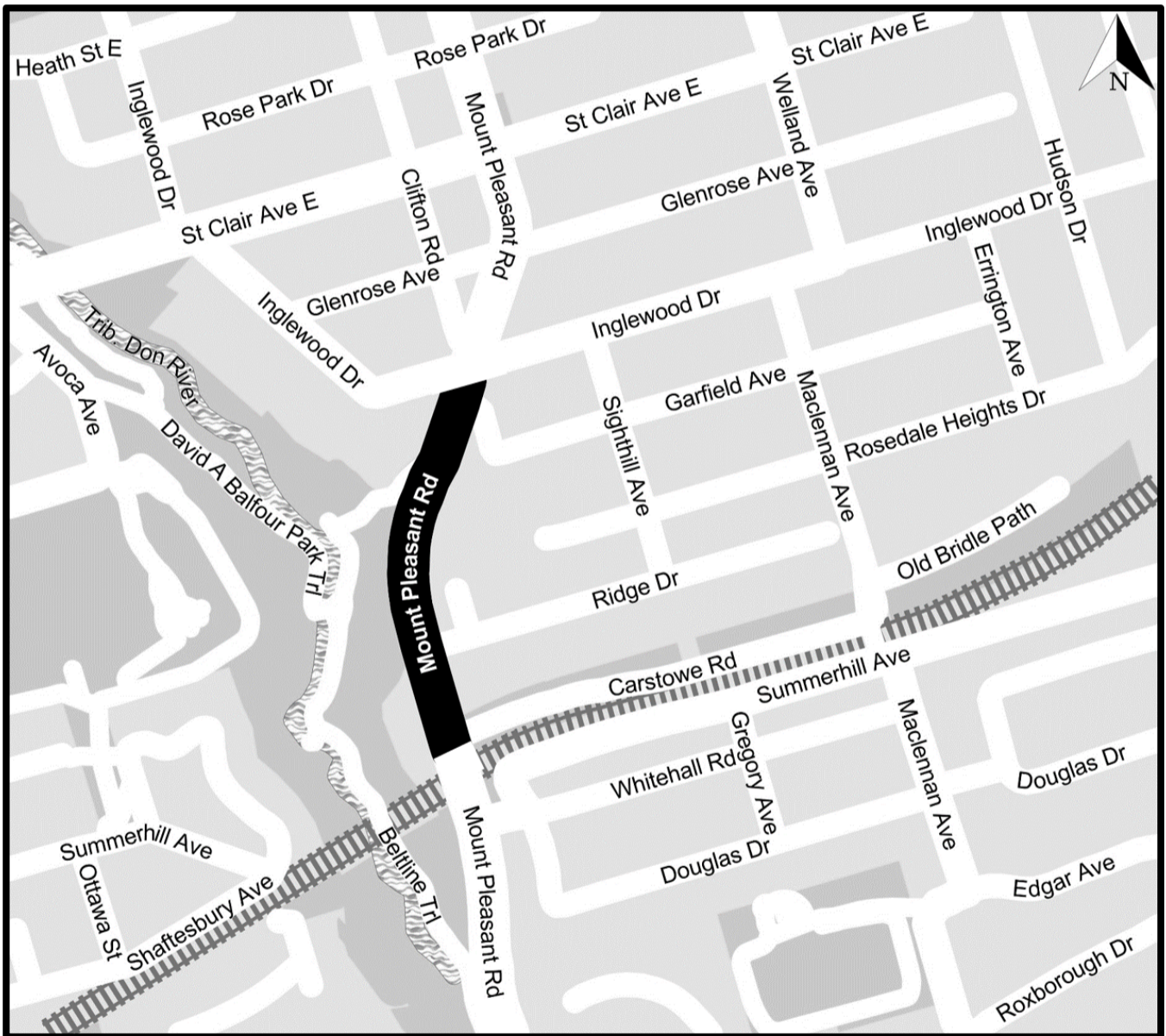
Expected End Date: December 31, 2018

The City of Toronto is planning to reconstruct the retaining walls on Mt. Pleasant Road from Carstowe Road to Garfield Avenue in the Fall. The retaining walls need rehabilitation and sections of retaining wall need to be reconstructed to bring them to a state of good repair.

The project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew aging city infrastructure for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Repair and refurbish the existing retaining wall
- Construct a new soldier pile wall
- Construct and install new steel railings
- Restore areas affected by construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. The east sidewalk will be closed but a temporary walkway will be provided adjacent to the work area.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Two Northbound narrowed lanes next to the walkway will be provided. Cyclists will share one of the northbound lanes with vehicles.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced.</p>
