Finch Hydro Corridor New Multi-Use Trail Construction from Birchmount Road to Pharmacy Avenue


Expected Start Date: Summer 2019 Expected End Date: Fall 2019 *Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.

In the Summer of 2019, the City of Toronto is planning to construct the portion of a multi-use trail in the Finch Hydro Corridor, south of McNicoll Avenue, from Birchmount Road to Pharmacy Avenue (see map).

This trail will provide a safe route for cyclists, pedestrians and other users, and establish connections to existing cycling infrastructure, other major multi-use trails, transit, and amenities in the community. The proposed trail segment, combined with existing segments within the Finch Corridor, will be part of a 6.5 km-long trail.

In early 2018, City staff held a public meeting about this project at L'Amoreaux Community Centre. At the meeting, staff indicated construction would start in 2018. There was extensive coordination needed between the City and utility companies that own and operate utilities within the corridor before construction could start. Details to finalize work plans are underway, and construction will now start in 2019. A pre-construction notice will be sent about 2 months before work starts in 2019.
